## **SKILL LEVEL - Beginner**

### **SIZE**

About 10 x 43 in. (25.5 x 109 cm), after seaming

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
  - 126 Sequoia 1 ball (A)
  - 109 Olympic 1 ball (B)
  - 107 Wind Cave 1 ball (C)
  - 111 Crater Lake 1 ball (D)
  - 172 Mesa Verde 1 ball (E)
  - 156 Guadalupe Mountains 1 ball (F)
  - 178 Pinnacles 1 ball (G)
- Martha Stewart Crafts™/MC Lion Brand® Yarn DIY Weaver™ Starter Kit
- Martha Stewart Crafts™/MC Lion Brand® Yarn DIY Weaver Extender™ Kit



### **NOTES**

1. Scarf is worked in 2 separate halves that are sewn together.
2. All of the yarns are used with 2 strands held together. Wind each ball of yarn into 2 separate balls before beginning.
3. Change yarn colors following our pattern or create your own striping pattern!

## **First Half of Scarf**

### **Loom Set-Up**

Following DIY Weaver Extender™ kit manual instructions, connect loom base from starter kit to loom base from extender kit.

Insert 28 standard pegs along top and bottom edges of connected loom bases – 56 pegs placed for warp.

### **Warp**

Following manual instructions for Warping and using 2 strands of A held together, set up the warp across 28 pegs.

### **Weft**

Following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, and using 2 strands of yarn held together for each color, work the weft as follows:

Weave about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) each with 2 strands held together of \*A, B, C and D; repeat from \* once, then weave remainder of warp with A.

Weave remainder of warp with A.

## **Remove Weaving From Loom**

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

## **Second Half of Scarf**

### **Loom Set-Up**

Set up the loom and the extender just as you did for the First Half of the Runner.

### **Warp**

Following manual instructions for Warping and using 2 strands of A held together, set up the warp across 28 pegs.

### **Weft**

Following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, and using 2 strands of yarn held together for each color, work the weft as follows:

Weave about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) each with 2 strands held together of \*G, F, A and E; repeat from \* once, then weave remainder of warp with A.

## **Remove Weaving From Loom**

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

## **FINISHING**

Lay Scarf halves end to end with right side facing. With A threaded into yarn needle provided with starter kit, work cross stitches back and forth between the halves to join them.

Weave in yarn ends.
