SKILL LEVEL – Beginner

<u>SIZES</u>

Finished Size About 8 in. (20.5 cm) wide, not including fringe.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Fast-Track (Art. #521)
 - 102 Cruise Ship Aqua 1 ball (A)
 - 157 Taxi Cab Yellow 1 ball (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Vanna's Glamour® (Art. #861)
 - 100 Diamond 1 ball (A)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Embroidery hoops, 8 in. (20.5 cm) and 4 in. (10 cm) in circumference Cabone rings, 2 in. (5 cm) in circumference Assorted beads as desired – be sure to check that bead holes are large enough to accommodate the blunt needle Assorted feathers as desired Craft Glue

MATERIALS NOTE

Materials are sufficient to make more than one Dreamcatcher.

NOTES

- 1. Dreamcatcher is made with 3 rings in graduated sizes. Follow the diagrams for how-tos.
- 2. Express your creativity by choosing beads, feathers, and fringe as desired to make the Dreamcatcher your own!

DREAMCATCHER

Wrap Small Ring

The cabone ring is the smallest ring.

Cut a 2 yd. (2 m) length of A.

Knot one end of A to the cabone ring. With A, wrap the ring overlapping the edges of the wraps slightly to completely cover the ring. When ring is completely wrapped, knot the end of A to the ring.

Trim end of A and glue to back of ring.

Wrap Medium Ring

The smaller embroidery hoop is the medium ring. Separate the smaller embroidery hoop and use only the inside hoop for wrapping.

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Wind B into a ball small enough to pass through the center hole of the ring, then wrap the ring just as you did for the small ring.

Wrap Large Ring

Separate the larger embroidery hoop and use only the inside hoop for wrapping. Wind a ball of A that is small enough to pass through the center hole of the ring, then wrap the ring just as you did for the small ring.

Connecting the Rings

Cut two 8 in. (20.5 cm) lengths of A and lay onto a flat surface. Lay the large and medium rings on top of the lengths, with the medium ring centered in the large ring. With the lengths of A, and following the diagram, tie the medium ring to the large ring at the top and bottom of the rings.

Outer Spokes

Wind C into a ball small enough to pass through the center of the medium ring. Knot one end of C to the medium ring.

Holding the medium and large rings together with the medium ring suspended in the center of the large ring, and referring to the diagram, wrap C around the outside of the large ring, then through the center of the medium ring. Continue around spacing the spokes 1/2 in. (1 cm) apart. When you're finished, knot the end of yarn to the large ring. Trim end of yarn and glue to back of ring.

Inner Spokes

Cut two 8 in. (20.5 cm) lengths of A. Center the small ring inside the medium ring and tie in place just as you did for the medium and large rings.

Cut a 3 yd. (3 m) length of C and thread into blunt needle. Tie the opposite end of yarn to the small ring then make inner spokes in the same way you made the outer spokes.

Weaving the Spokes

Cut a 5 yd. (4.5 m) length of B and thread into blunt needle. Thread beads as desired onto the B strand. Weave B over and under the spokes between the medium and large rings.

Continue weaving around until the entire length has been woven.

Cut a 5 yd. (4.5 m) length of A and thread into blunt needle. Add beads if desired and weave A length just as you did for B length.

Trim ends of yarn and glue to back of Dreamcatcher.

FINISHING

Fringe

Cut 40 in. (101.5 cm) lengths of A and B. Fold each length in half, pass looped end through the bottom of the large ring and pull the yarn ends through the loop. Trim fringe to desired length. Make as much fringe as you like.

Beads

Thread an end of fringe into blunt needle, then slide beads as desired on to fringe. Knot fringe to hold the beads in place.

Feathers

Push the quill end of the feather up through knot in fringe and through bead. Apply a tiny amount of craft glue to the back of the feather close to the knot and press against the fringe to secure. Allow glue to dry.

Hanger

Cut a 16 in. (40.5 cm) length of C and double knot ends to top of large ring about 6 in. (15 cm) apart.
