Dallas Tank Top

SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZES

XS/S (M/L, 1X/2X)

Finished Bust About 36 (44, 52) in. (91.5 (112, 132) cm)

Finished Back Length About 27 (28, 29) in. (68.5 (71, 73.5) cm)

Finished Front Length About 24 (25, 26) in. (61 (63.5, 66) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Fast-Track (Art. #521)
 - 108 Dune Buggy Denim 2 (3, 3) balls (A)
 - 102 Cruise Ship Aqua 2 (3, 3) balls (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 17 (13 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

9 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

1. Top is made in 2 separate pieces: Front and Back.
2. Each piece is worked from the lower edge up; the Front is shorter than the Back.

FRONT

With A, cast on 40 (50, 58) sts.

With A, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS (purl) row as the last row you work.

Change to B.

With B, work in St st for about 3 in. (7.5 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Armholes

Continue with B only.

Row 1 (Decrease Row – RS): K1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – you will have 38 (48, 56) sts in this row.

Row 2: Purl.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for 4 (6, 8) more times – 30 (36, 40) sts when all decreases have been completed.

Work even (without increasing or decreasing) in St st until armholes measure about 11 (12, 13) in. (28 (30.5, 33) cm).

Bind off.

BACK

With A, cast on 40 (50, 58) sts.

With A, work in St st until piece measures about 13 in. (33 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Change to B.

With B, work in St st for about 3 in. (7.5 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Armholes

Continue with B only.

Row 1 (Decrease Row – RS): K1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 38 (48, 56) sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for 4 (6, 8) more times – 30 (36, 40) sts when all decreases have been completed.

Work even in St st until armholes measure same as Front.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew side seams, leaving about 5 in. (12.5 cm) of lower Front and about 8 in. (20.5 cm) of lower Back unsewn for side slits.

Sew shoulder seams leaving about 9 1/2 (10, 10 1/2) in. (24 (25.5, 26.5) cm) at center unsewn for neck.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side
