# SKILL LEVEL - Intermediate

## SIZE

About 16 x 60 in. (40.5 x 152.5 cm)

# **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
  - 109 Olympic 2 balls (A)
  - 105 Glacier Bay 2 balls (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



# **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

3 1/2 x 3 1/2 in. (9 x 9 cm) piece of heavy cardboard

## **GAUGE**

One Motif = about 4 in. (10 cm) across at widest point. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

# **STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

shell (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in indicated sp.

# **SPECIAL TECHNIQUES**

motif-join (join motif to neighboring motif at ch-2 sps of shells) Ch 1, remove loop from hook, insert hook in corresponding ch-2 sp of neighboring Motif, return loop to hook and draw through the ch-2 sp, ch 1.

## NOTES

- 1. Shawl is made from 69 Motifs. Each Motif is worked in 2 rnds. Each rnd is a different color.
- 2. Motifs are joined following an Assembly Diagram and using a join-as-you-go technique.

## **CENTER STRIP**

#### Motif 1

With A, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as first tr), work 17 tr in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 18 tr.

Fasten off.

Rnd 2: From RS, join B with sl st in sp between any 2 sts, ch 3 (counts as first dc), (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same sp between sts (beg shell made), \*sk next 2 sps between sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next sp between sts (shell made); rep from \* 4 more times.

sk last 2 sps between sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 6 shells. Fasten off.

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## Motifs 2-15

Rnd 1: Work same as Motif 1 – 18 tr.

Fasten off.

#### Notes:

- 1. Each Motif is joined to neighboring Motif(s) across one or more ch-2 sps of shells using a join-as-you-go technique. Read the instructions for "motif join" in the Special Techniques section carefully before beginning.
- 2. Before working Rnd 2, refer to Assembly Diagram for placement. Note the number of neighboring Motifs to which the current Motif needs to be joined.
- 3. When joining, hold the current Motif and the neighboring Motif with WS tog, sts matching, and RS of current Motif facing you.

Rnd 2 (Joining Rnd): From RS, join B with sl st in sp between any 2 sts, ch 3 (counts as first dc), (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same sp between sts (beg shell made), \*sk next 2 sps between sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next sp between sts (shell made); rep from \* 3 more times, sk next 2 sps between sts, (2 dc, work motif-join, 2 dc) in next sp between sts (joining shell made), sk last 2 sps between sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 6 shells. Fasten off.

# STRIP I

#### Motif 16

Rnd 1: Work same as Motif 1 – 18 tr.

Fasten off.

**Note:** Motif 16 is joined to 2 previous Motifs, continue to follow Assembly Diagram for placement.

Rnd 2 (Joining Rnd): From RS, join B with sl st in sp between any 2 sts, ch 3 (counts as first dc), (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same sp between sts (beg shell made), \*sk next 2 sps between sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next sp between sts (shell made); rep from \* 2 more times, \*\*sk next 2 sps between sts, (2 dc, work motif-join to join to Motif 1, 2 dc) in next sp between sts (joining shell made); rep from \*\* once more joining to Motif 2, sk last 2 sps between sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 6 shells.

Fasten off.

# Motifs 17-29

Rnd 1: Work same as Motif 1 – 18 tr.

Fasten off.

**Note:** Each Motif is joined to 3 previous Motifs. Continue to follow Assembly Diagram for placement.

**Rnd 2 (Joining Rnd):** From RS, join B with sl st in sp between any 2 sts, ch 3 (counts as first dc), (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same sp between sts (beg shell made), \*sk next 2 sps between sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next sp between sts (shell made); rep from \* once more, \*\*sk next 2 sps between sts, (2 dc, work motif-join, 2 dc) in next sp between sts (joining shell made); rep from \*\* 2 more times joining to the next neighboring Motif each time, sk last 2 sps between sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 6 shells.

Fasten off.

Work same as Strip I, following Assembly Diagram for placement.

## **FINISHING**

# Tassels (make 10)

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, wrap yarn around cardboard 10 times. Cut a 16 in. (40.5 cm) length of A and thread, doubled, into large-eyed blunt needle. Insert needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard. Cut a 12 in. (30.5 cm) length of A and wrap tightly around loops 1 in. (2.5 cm) below top knot to form Tassel neck. Knot securely and thread ends through center of Tassel. Trim Tassel ends evenly. Tie one Tassel to ch-sp at each end of each Strip and thread tie ends through center of tassels and trim ends evenly – 5 Tassels across each end of Shawl.

Weave in ends.
