

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand[®] Heartland[®] Buttoned Poncho

SKILL LEVEL - Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 49 1/2 in. (125.5 cm) across longest edge

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
 - 098 Acadia 1 ball (A)
 - 122 Grand Canyon 1 ball (B)
 - 149 Great Smoky Mountains 1 ball (C)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® split ring stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

6 buttons, 1 in. (25 mm) diameter

<u>GAUGE</u>

One Square = $5 \frac{1}{2} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ in. (14 x 14 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Poncho is made from 36 Squares joined together as shown in Assembly Diagram.
- 2. Squares are worked in joined rnds with RS facing. Color is changed every 1-2 rnds by fastening off old color and joining new color as instructed.

SQUARE (make 36)

With A, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, 3 sc in ring, (ch 2, 3 sc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in first sc – 12 sc and 4 ch-2 sps.

Fasten off.

Rnd 2: From RS, draw up a loop of B in any ch-2 sp, ch 1, 2 sc in same ch-2 sp, (ch 4, 2 sc in next ch-2 sp) 3 times, ch 4; join with sl st in first sc – 8 sc and 4 ch-4 sps.

Rnd 3: SI st in next sc, *(sI st, ch 2, 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc, ch 2, sI st) in next ch-4 sp, ch 2; rep from * 3 more times, ch 2, sI st in first ch-4 sp again – 16 dc, 12 ch-2 sps, and 4 ch-1 sps.

Fasten off.

Rnd 4: From RS, draw up a loop of C in any ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), (2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same ch-1 sp, sk next ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, *sk next ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp; (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 48 dc, 8 ch-1 sps.

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Fasten off.

Rnd 5: From RS, join B with sc in first ch-1 sp of Rnd 4, sk next dc, hdc in next dc, dc in next dc, sk next 3 dc, (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in next ch-1 sp, sk next 3 dc, dc in next dc, hdc in next dc, sk next dc, *sc in next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, hdc in next dc, dc in next dc, sk next 3 dc, (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in next ch-1 sp, sk next 3 dc, dc in next dc, hdc in next dc, sk next dc; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 6: From RS, join C with sc in any ch-1 sp, ch 1, sc in same ch-1 sp (first corner made), (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st) 5 times, *ch 1, sk next st, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next ch-1 sp (corner made), (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st) 5 times; rep from * around, ch 1; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Join Squares into Strips

Arrange Squares into 3 Strips of 9 Squares each and 3 Strips of 3 Squares each. Join neighboring Squares as follows:

Joining Row (RS): Hold two Squares with WS tog and sts matching. Working through both thicknesses from RS, join C with sc in corner ch-1 sp at beg of edge to be joined, *ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across edge working last sc in corner ch-1 sp at other end of edge. Fasten off.

Join Strips

Join Strips tog to form an L-shape, as shown in Assembly Diagram, as follows: Hold two Strips with WS tog and sts matching. Working through both thicknesses from RS, join C with sc in corner ch-1 sp at beg of edge to be joined, *ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp or join between Squares; rep from * all the way across to end of edge to be joined working last sc in corner ch-1 sp at other end of edge. Fasten off.

Button Band

Note: Button band is worked across outer edge of short leg of L-shaped piece, as shown in Assembly Diagram.

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join C with sc in corner ch-1 sp at beg of button band edge, sc in each sc and ch-1 sp all the way across button band edge, working last sc in corner ch-1 sp at other end of button band edge.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

Buttonholes and Border

Notes: Border is worked across rem outer edges of L-shaped piece, not including button band. Buttonholes are worked evenly spaced across top inner edge of long leg of L-shaped piece, as Border is worked. Locations for beg border and placing buttonhole markers are shown in Assembly Diagram. Place 6 markers evenly spaced across buttonhole edge.

From RS, join C with sc in corner ch-1 sp at end of button band edge working towards inner corner of L-shaped piece, (*ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to next buttonhole marker, ch 3, sk next sc, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next sc (for buttonhole), sc in next ch-1 sp or join between Squares) 6 times, **ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from ** all the way around rem edges of Poncho working (sc, ch 1, sc) in each outer corner ch-1 sp and ending at other end of button band.

Sew buttons to button band opposite buttonholes.

Weave in ends.
