SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

SIZES

XS/S (M/L, 1X/2X)

Finished Bust 40 (49, 58) in. (101.5 (124.5, 147.5) cm), not including edgings **Finished Length** 16 (19, 21) in. (40.5 (48.5, 53.5) cm), not including edgings **Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homespun® (Art. #790)
 - 436 Claret 3 (5, 6) balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

10 1/2 dc + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Jacket is made from 2 Halves.
- Each Half is worked from the armhole edge outwards. Increases are worked at 2 locations in each row to shape piece. Sts before and following the increase locations will form the sides, and sts between the increase locations will form the lower edge of each Half.
- 3. Sleeves are worked, back and forth in rows, directly into armholes.

RIGHT HALF

Ch 46 (56, 64).

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), dc in next 15 (18, 20) ch (for side section), ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next 2 ch, ch 1, sk next ch (for first increase location), dc in next 2 (6, 10) ch (for center section), ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next 2 ch, ch 1, sk next ch (for second increase location), dc in last 17 (20, 22) ch (for side section) – you will have 40 (50, 58) dc and 4 ch-1 sps in this row (17 (20, 22) dc in each side section and 2 (6, 10) dc in center section).

Row 2 (Increase Row): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, (dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, dc in each dc to end of row – 18 (21, 23) dc in each side section and 4 (8, 12) dc in center section.

Row 3 (Increase Row): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, (dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, 2 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, dc in each dc to end of row -20 (23, 25) dc in each side section and 8 (12, 16) dc in center section.

Rows 4-10 (12, 14): Rep Row 3 for 7 (9, 11) more times – 34 (41, 47) dc in each side section and 36 (48, 60) dc in center section.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, (dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, 2 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, dc in each dc to last 7 (8, 9) sts; leave rem sts unworked – 36 (43, 49) dc in first side section, 40 (52, 64) dc in center section, and 29 (35, 40) dc in second side section.

Rows 2-4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, (dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, 2 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, dc in each dc to end of row -42 (49, 55) dc in first side section, 52 (64, 76) dc in center section, and 35 (41, 46) dc in second side section.

Fasten off.

LEFT HALF

Make same as Right Half to Shape Neck.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 7 (8, 9) sts, ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next st, (dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, 2 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, dc to end of row - 36 (43, 49) dc in first side section, 40 (52, 64) dc in center section, and 29 (35, 40) dc in second side section.

Rows 2-4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, (dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, 2 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, dc in each dc to end of row -42 (49, 55) dc in first side section, 52 (64, 76) dc in center section, and 35 (41, 46) dc in second side section.

Do not fasten off. Remove loop from hook and enlarge loop, or place it on a stitch marker or safety pin, so that it does not unravel.

Sew back edges of Right and Left Half together for back seam. Sew shoulder seams.

Front and Lower Edging

Return loop attached to Left Half to hook.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, working along Left Half front edge, dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, 2 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp; working along Left Half lower edge, dc in each dc to sp before back seam, 3 dc in sp before seam; working along Right Half lower edge, 3 dc in sp following seam, dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, 2 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp; working along Right Half front edge, dc in each dc to end of row.

Do NOT fasten off.

Edging

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, do not turn, working along neck edge, work 9 (10, 11) sc evenly spaced along front neck edge, 9 sc along right neck edge, 16 (18, 20) sc along back neck edge, 9 sc along left neck edge, 9 (10, 11) sc along front neck

edge, ch 1, (sc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, 2 sc in ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 dc, 2 sc in next ch-1 sp) twice, sc in each dc to end of rnd; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2 (WS): Ch 1, turn, sl st in each sc around; join with sl st in beg ch-1. Fasten off.

SLEEVES

From RS and working along opposite side of foundation ch, draw up a loop of yarn in ch-1 sp at corner of one underarm so that you are ready to work up side edge of armhole.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in ch at base of each st along armhole edge to shoulder seam, dc in ch at base of each st along next armhole edge to next ch-1 sp, dc in ch-1 sp; leave underarm sts unworked.

Rows 2-8: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each dc across.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc across.

Row 10 (WS): Ch 1, turn, sl st in each st across.

Fasten off.

Rep along second armhole for second sleeve.

FINISHING

Sew sides of top of each sleeve to underarm edges. Sew sleeve seams.

Weave in ends.
