## SKILL LEVEL – Beginner

## <u>SIZE</u>

About 4 in. (10 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® DIYarn (Art. #205)
  - 149 Grey 1 ball (A)
    - 100 White 1 ball (B)
    - 150 Charcoal 1 ball (C)
    - 101 Pink 1 ball (D)
- Lion Brand® Pom-Pom Makers, Large and Extra Small

## **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Small pieces of felt in grey, black, white and pink Small beads – 2 for each Bunny Craft glue

#### **NOTES**

- 1. Bunnies are not meant to be toys do not allow small children to play with these Bunnies.
- 2. Change the yarn colors in the pattern to make the Bunnies your own.
- 3. Yarn amounts are sufficient to make multiple Bunnies.

#### **BUNNY**

With large pom-pom maker, following the package instructions and with A, B or C, make 2 pom-poms for each Bunny – one in the largest size and one in the smaller size.

Glue 2 matching color pom-poms together for each Bunny.

With extra small pom-pom maker and B, make a pom-pom for each Bunny tail and with D, make a pom-pom for each Bunny nose.

Trim the nose pom-pom to be as small as possible.

Glue nose and tail to each Bunny.

## **FINISHING**

#### Ears

Cut 2 small ear shapes from felt for each Bunny, then cut 2 smaller ear shapes from a contrast color of felt.

Glue smaller ears onto larger ears, then glue ears to Bunny.

Glue 2 beads to each Bunny for eyes.
