

# Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Homespun® Hearthside Ripple Afghan Pattern Number: L40068

## SKILL LEVEL - Easy

### <u>SIZE</u>

About 42 x 54 in. (106.5 x 137 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Homespun® (Art. #790)
  - 312 Edwardian 2 skeins (A)
  - 315 Tudor 2 skeins (B)
  - 407 Painted Desert 2 skeins (C)
- Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

## <u>GAUGE</u>

1 ripple = about 6 in. (15 cm), measured from peak to peak. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work 6 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 4 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 4 rows with B, 6 rows with C, 4 rows with A, 6 rows with B, 6 rows with C, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with C, 4 rows with B, and 4 rows with A.

#### <u>NOTES</u>

- 1. This project is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
- 2. The ripple pattern consists of alternating 3-st "peaks" and skipped st "valleys". Take care to keep the peaks and valleys of each row aligned. 3 sts are worked into the center st of peaks, and sts are skipped over valleys.
- 3. When working in ripple crochet, your piece may not lay flat until you've worked a few rows.
- 4. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.

#### <u>AFGHAN</u>

With A, ch 146.

**Row 1:** Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*sc in next 7 ch, sk next ch, sc in next 7 ch, 3 sc in next ch; rep from \* to last 16 ch, sc in next 7 ch, sk next ch, sc in next 7 ch, 2 sc in last ch – 9 ripples.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc in first sc, \*dc in next 7 sc, sk next 2 sc, dc in next 7 sc, 3 dc in next sc; rep from \* to last 17 sts, dc in next 7 sc, sk next 2 sc, dc in next 7 sc, 2 dc in last sc.



**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first dc, \*sc in next 7 dc, sk next 2 dc, sc in next 7 dc, 3 sc in next dc; rep from \* to last 17 sts, sc in next 7 dc, sk next 2 dc, sc in next 7 dc, 2 sc in top of turning ch.

Rep last 2 rows, changing color following Stripe Sequence until all 54 rows of Stripe Sequence have been worked. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

ch = chain dc = double crochet rep = repeat sc = single crochet sk = skip st (s) = stitch(es)
