SKILL LEVEL – Beginner

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 26-40 in. (66-101.5 cm), or as desired.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® DIYarn (Art. #205)
 - 133 Orange 1 ball
 - 157 Yellow 1 ball
 - 147 Purple 1 ball
 - 113 Red 1 ball
 - 102 Aqua 1 ball
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Binder clip

4 x 4 in. (10 x 10 cm) piece of cardboard

NOTE

General instructions are given for Necklaces, get creative and use colors as desired!

SHORT NECKLACE

1. Cut 6 strands of yarn, each about 90 in. (228.5 cm) long.
2. Hold strands together and fold in half. Tie an overhand knot just below the fold to make a loop.
3. Divide strands into 3 groups of 4 strands each. Braid the groups together until about 8 in. (20.5 cm) remains unbraided. Fold the unbraided strands around the loop made in Step 2 and hold in place with the binder clip.
4. Cut a strand of yarn about 20 in. (51 cm) long and wrap tightly around the strands above the clip. Remove clip. Thread yarn ends (3-4 at a time) into blunt needle and draw ends under the wrap to hide.

MEDIUM NECKLACE

Cut 6 strands of yarn, each about 115 in. (292 cm) long, then repeat Steps 2-4 of Short Necklace.

LONG NECKLACE

Cut 6 strands of yarn, each about 140 in. (355.5 cm) long, then repeat Steps 2-4 of Short Necklace.

FINISHING

Cut 20 in. (51 cm) strands of yarn. Thread strands, one at a time, into needle and wrap around braid at center. Draw ends under wraps to secure. Weave in any remaining yarn ends.

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Tassel

With colors as desired, wrap yarn around 4 in. (10 cm) cardboard as many times as desired. The more wraps, the fuller the tassel. Cut an 8 in. (20.5 cm) length and thread doubled into blunt needle. Insert needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard. Cut an 8 in. (20.5 cm) length of yarn and wrap tightly around loops 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) below top knot to form tassel neck. Knot securely; thread ends into needle and weave ends to center of Tassel.

With tassel tie, tie onto Necklaces as desired. Trim Tassel ends evenly.
