



***Free Knitting Pattern***  
**Lion Brand® Scarfie®**  
**Cabled Bun Hat**  
Pattern Number: L70001



## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy**

### **SIZE**

About 11 x 48 in. (28 x 122 cm), at longest and widest points

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Scarfie® (Art. #826)
  - 216 Cream/Silver 1 ball
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® double pointed knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® cable needle
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

32 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-4 of pattern.  
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

**2/2 LC (2 over 2 left cross)** Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

**RT (Right Twist)** K2tog and leave on left hand needle, then with right hand needle, go between the 2 sts and k the first st again.

#### **Yo (yarn over)**

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new stitch. You are now ready to proceed with the next stitch as instructed.

### **NOTES**

1. Hat is worked in one piece and then seamed.
2. The top of the Hat is open.
3. Yarn overs are worked every 4 rows to create eyelets. A knitted cord is worked separately, then woven through the eyelets to shape the top of the Hat.

### **HAT**

With straight needles, cast on 48 sts.

**Rows 1 and 3 (Wrong Side):** K2, \*p4, k2, p2, k2; rep from \* to last 6 sts, p4, k2.

**Row 2:** K1, p1, \*k4, p2, RT, p2; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k4, p1, k1.

**Row 4:** K1, p1, \*2/2 LC, p2, RT, p2; rep from \* to last 16 sts, 2/2 LC, p2, RT, yo, p2tog, 2/2 LC, p1, k1.

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Rep Rows 1-4 until piece measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Bind off.

### **FINISHING**

**Sew ends of piece together to make a ring.**

#### **Knitted Cord**

With 2 double pointed needles, cast on 3 sts. Knit the 3 sts. Do not turn work.

\*Slide sts to other end of needle and knit them, pulling yarn tightly across the back of the work, (do not turn work); rep from \* until cord measures about 31 in. (78.5 cm) long.

Bind off.

Weave cord through the yarn over eyelets, then knot ends of cord together.

Weave in ends.

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

rep = repeat

st(s) = stitch(es)
