## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy+**

### **SIZE**

About 45 x 52 in. (114.5 x 132 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
  - 104 Zion 1 ball (A)
  - 113 Redwood 1 ball (B)
  - 148 Badlands 1 ball (C)
  - 135 Yosemite 1 ball (D)
  - 126 Sequoia 1 ball (E)
  - 122 Grand Canyon 1 ball (F)
  - 098 Acadia 1 ball (G)
  - 109 Olympic 1 ball (H)
  - 171 Cuyahoga Valley 1 ball (I)
  - 178 Pinnacles 1 ball (J)
  - 173 Everglades 1 ball (K)
  - 180 Kings Canyon 1 ball (L)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Circular knitting needle size 9 (5.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

### **GAUGE**

Make a Garter stitch swatch before beginning to check your gauge.

16 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row).

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

**kfb (knit in front and back)** Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

**ssk (slip, slip, knit)** Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog – 1 st decreased.

#### **yo (yarn over)**

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

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## **NOTES**

1. 6 Strips are worked separately, then sewn together following a diagram.
2. Each Strip is made from 7 Garter stitch triangles. Yarn color is changed to make stripes.
3. Stitches for border are picked up along outside edges of the Afghan.
4. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of border stitches. Straight needles or a circular needle can be used to knit the Strips. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working with straight needles.

## **STRIP I**

### **First Triangle**

**Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with H, 4 rows with L; rep from \* to end of first triangle.

Cast on 1 st.

**Row 1 (RS):** (K1, yo, k1) all in st – you will have 3 sts.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Row 3:** K1, (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, k1 – 5 sts.

**Row 4:** Knit.

**Row 5:** K1, kfb, k to end of row – 6 sts.

**Row 6:** Knit.

**Rows 7-42:** Rep Rows 5 and 6 eighteen times – 24 sts at the end of Row 41.

**Row 43 (RS):** K1, k2tog, k to end of row – 23 sts.

**Row 44:** Knit.

**Rows 45-84:** Rep Rows 43 and 44 twenty times – 3 sts at the end of Row 83.

**Row 85 (RS):** K1, k2tog – 2 sts.

**Row 86:** Knit.

**Row 87:** K2tog.

Fasten off rem st.

### **Second Triangle**

**Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with H, 4 rows with I, 2 rows with J; rep from \* to end of second triangle.

From RS, pick up and k45 sts evenly spaced along unshaped side edge of previous triangle.

Knit 1 row.

**Row 1 (RS):** K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 44 sts.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Rows 3-84:** Rep Rows 1 and 2 forty-one times – 3 sts at the end of Row 83.

**Row 85 (RS):** K1, k2tog – 2 sts.

**Row 86:** Knit.

**Row 87:** K2tog.

Fasten off rem st.

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### Third Triangle

**Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with J, 6 rows with K; rep from \* to end of third triangle.

From RS, pick up and k45 sts evenly spaced along unshaped side edge of previous triangle.

Knit 1 row.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, ssk, k to end of row – 44 sts.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Rows 3-84:** Rep Rows 1 and 2 forty-one times – 3 sts at the end of Row 83.

**Row 85 (RS):** K1, ssk – 2 sts.

**Row 86:** Knit.

**Row 87:** K2tog.

Fasten off rem st.

### Fourth Triangle

Work same as second triangle, changing color as follows:

\*Work 6 rows with F, 4 rows with G, 2 rows with K; rep from \* to end of fourth triangle.

### Fifth Triangle

Work same as third triangle, changing color as follows:

\*Work 2 rows with E, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with F; rep from \* to end of fifth triangle.

### Sixth Triangle

Work same as second triangle, changing color as follows:

\*Work 8 rows with E, 6 rows with C, 4 rows with B; rep from \* to end of sixth triangle.

### Seventh Triangle

**Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with B, 2 rows with D; rep from \* to end of seventh triangle.

From RS, pick up and k45 sts evenly spaced along unshaped side edge of previous triangle.

Knit 1 row.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 43 sts.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Rows 3-40:** Rep Rows 1 and 2 nineteen times – 5 sts at the end of Row 39.

**Row 41 (RS):** K1, k3tog, k1 – 3 sts.

**Row 42:** Knit.

**Row 43:** K3tog.

Fasten off rem st.

## **STRIP II**

### **First Triangle**

**Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with H, 2 rows with L, 2 rows with C; rep from \* to end of first triangle.

Cast on 1 st.

**Row 1 (RS):** (K1, yo, k1) all in st – you will have 3 sts.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Row 3:** K1, (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, k1 – 5 sts.

**Row 4:** Knit.

**Row 5:** K to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 6 sts.

**Row 6:** Knit.

**Rows 7-42:** Rep Rows 5 and 6 eighteen times – 24 sts at the end of Row 41.

**Row 43 (RS):** K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 23 sts.

**Row 44:** Knit.

**Rows 45-84:** Rep Rows 43 and 44 twenty times – 3 sts at the end of Row 83.

**Row 85 (RS):** K1, k2tog – 2 sts.

**Row 86:** Knit.

**Row 87:** K2tog.

Fasten off rem st.

### **Second Triangle**

**Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with C, 2 rows with B; rep from \* to end of second triangle.

From RS, pick up and k45 sts evenly spaced along unshaped side edge of previous triangle.

Knit 1 row.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, ssk, k to end of row – 44 sts.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Rows 3-84:** Rep Rows 1 and 2 forty-one times – 3 sts at the end of Row 83.

**Row 85:** K1, ssk – 2 sts.

**Row 86:** Knit.

**Row 87:** Ssk.

Fasten off rem st.

### **Third Triangle**

**Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 6 rows with H, 4 rows with J, 2 rows with K; rep from \* to end of third triangle.

From RS, pick up and k45 sts evenly spaced along unshaped side edge of previous triangle.

Knit 1 row.

**Row 1 (RS):** K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 44 sts.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Rows 3-84:** Rep Rows 1 and 2 forty-one times – 3 sts at the end of Row 83.

**Row 85:** K1, k2tog – 2 sts.

**Row 86:** Knit.

**Row 87:** K2tog.

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Fasten off rem st.

### **Fourth Triangle**

Work same as second triangle, changing color as follows:

\*Work 4 rows with L, 2 rows with K, 2 rows with D; rep from \* to end of fourth triangle.

### **Fifth Triangle**

Work same as third triangle, changing color as follows:

\*Work 6 rows with D, 4 rows with F; rep from \* to end of fifth triangle.

### **Sixth Triangle**

Work same as second triangle, changing color as follows:

\*Work 4 rows with H, 2 rows with F, 2 rows with G; rep from \* to end of sixth triangle.

### **Seventh Triangle**

**Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with E, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A; rep from \* to end of seventh triangle.

From RS, pick up and k45 sts evenly spaced along unshaped side edge of previous triangle.

Knit 1 row.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 43 sts.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Rows 3-40:** Rep Rows 1 and 2 nineteen times – 5 sts at the end of Row 39.

**Row 41:** K1, k3tog, k1 – 3 sts.

**Row 86:** Knit.

**Row 87:** K3tog.

Fasten off rem st.

### **STRIP III**

Work same as Strip I, using the following Stripe Sequences.

**First Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with I, 4 rows with L; rep from \* to end of first triangle.

**Second Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with D, 4 rows with B, 2 rows with C; rep from \* to end of second triangle.

**Third Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 6 rows with K, 4 rows with E, 2 rows with F; rep from \* to end of third triangle.

**Fourth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with I, 4 rows with J, 2 rows with K; rep from \* to end of fourth triangle.

**Fifth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with C, 2 rows with B, 4 rows with A; rep from \* to end of fifth triangle.

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**Sixth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with C, 2 rows with H, 2 rows with A; rep from \* to end of sixth triangle.

**Seventh Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with I, 2 rows with E, 2 rows with J; rep from \* to end of seventh triangle.

#### **STRIP IV**

Work same as Strip II, using the following Stripe Sequences.

**First Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with L, 2 rows with I, 2 rows with J, 2 rows with H; rep from \* to end of first triangle.

**Second Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with F, 4 rows with E, 6 rows with D; rep from \* to end of second triangle.

**Third Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with L, 2 rows with K, 2 rows with G; rep from \* to end of third triangle.

**Fourth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 6 rows with F, 4 rows with C, 2 rows with H; rep from \* to end of fourth triangle.

**Fifth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 6 rows with E, 2 rows with C, 4 rows with B, 2 rows with A; rep from \* to end of fifth triangle.

**Sixth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with L, 2 rows with D, 2 rows with K; rep from \* to end of sixth triangle.

**Seventh Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with I, 4 rows with H; rep from \* to end of seventh triangle.

#### **STRIP V**

Work same as Strip I, using the following Stripe Sequences.

**First Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with D, 2 rows with C, 4 rows with B, 2 rows with E; rep from \* to end of first triangle.

**Second Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with K, 4 rows with G, 4 rows with D; rep from \* to end of second triangle.

**Third Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with E, 2 rows with I, 4 rows with J; rep from \* to end of third triangle.

**Fourth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with F, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with H; rep from \* to end of fourth triangle.

**Fifth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with B, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with E, 2 rows with G; rep from \* to end of fifth triangle.

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**Sixth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 6 rows with K, 4 rows with J, 2 rows with D; rep from \* to end of sixth triangle.

**Seventh Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with H, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with D; rep from \* to end of seventh triangle.

## **STRIP VI**

Work same as Strip II, using the following Stripe Sequences.

**First Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with F, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A; rep from \* to end of first triangle.

**Second Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 6 rows with F, 4 rows with L, 2 rows with K; rep from \* to end of second triangle.

**Third Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with I, 4 rows with H, 2 rows with G, 2 rows with J; rep from \* to end of third triangle.

**Fourth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 6 rows with E, 4 rows with K, 2 rows with F; rep from \* to end of fourth triangle.

**Fifth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 2 rows with L, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with D; rep from \* to end of fifth triangle.

**Sixth Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with I, 4 rows with K, 2 rows with H; rep from \* to end of sixth triangle.

**Seventh Triangle Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 4 rows with E, 4 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with K; rep from \* to end of seventh triangle.

## **FINISHING**

Sew Strips together following the diagram.

### **Upper and Lower Borders**

From RS with circular needle and C, pick up and k198 sts evenly spaced across top edge of Afghan.

Knit 1 row.

Bind off.

With H, repeat border across lower edge of Afghan.

### **Side Borders**

From RS with circular needle and F, pick up and k220 sts evenly spaced along left side edge of Afghan.

Knit 1 row.

Bind off.

With L, repeat border along right side edge of Afghan.

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Weave in ends.

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

k3tog = knit 3 stitches together

p = purl

rem = remain(ing)(s)

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together
