SKILL LEVEL – Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 44 x 44 in. (112 x 112 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Mandala® (Art. #525)
 - 212 Spirit 3 balls (A)
 - 216 Sphinx 2 balls (B)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

<u>GAUGE</u>

20 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter stitch (knit every st on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



- 1. 16 Squares are worked individually, then sewn together.
- 2. Each Square is worked in 7 sections, following a diagram.
- 3. Borders are worked separately, then sewn to Lapghan.
- 4. Mandala is a self-striping yarn your Lapghan will be beautiful, but may not look exactly like the photographed Lapghan.

SQUARES (make 16)

Center

With A, cast on 12 sts. Work in Garter st (knit every st on every row) for 18 rows. Change to B. Continue in Garter st with B for 18 rows, then change to A and continue in Garter st for 18 rows. Bind off.

Section 1

From RS with A, and following diagram, pick up and knit 28 sts evenly spaced along one side of center.

Work in Garter st for 17 rows. Bind off.

Section 2

With B, and following diagram, work as for Section 1.

Section 3

From RS with B and following diagram, pick up and knit 30 sts evenly spaced. Work in Garter st for 17 rows.

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Bind off.

Section 4

With A and following diagram, work as for Section 3.

Section 5

From RS with B and following diagram, pick up and knit 46 sts evenly spaced. Work in Garter st for 17 rows. Bind off.

Section 6

With A and following diagram, work as for Section 5.

FINISHING

Sew Squares into 4 strips of 4 Squares each. Sew strips together to make Lapghan.

Side Borders (make 2)

Note: For the borders shown, we changed yarn color every 18 rows. Make the design your own by changing color as desired – or by using just one color yarn for each border!

With color of your choice, cast on 12 sts.

Work in Garter st, changing yarn color as desired, until border measures same length as side of Lapghan.

Bind off.

Sew border to one side of Lapghan.

Make a second border, then sew to opposite side of Lapghan.

Top and Bottom Borders (make 2)

Cast on and work same as side borders – but make these borders same length as top and bottom of Lapghan, including side borders.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side st(s) = stitch(es)
