

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Mandala® Pennant Scarf

SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

About 19 x 60 in. (48.5 x 152.5 cm) at widest and longest

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Mandala® (Art. #525)
 - 213 Wizard 1 ball
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-6 of pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Yo (yarn over)

An increase worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.
- 3. On wrong side rows, the yarn over is knit through the back loop this closes the hole made by the yarn over.

NOTES

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece with yarn over increases along one edge for shaping.
- 2. The Scarf is worked in Garter stitch (knit every st on every row), so is reversible.

SCARF

Cast on 5 sts.

Rows 1-4: Knit.

Row 5: Knit 2, yo, knit to end of row – 6 sts at the end of this row.

Row 6: Knit to last 3 sts, knit the yarn over through the back loop, knit 2.

Repeat Rows 1-6 until about 2 yds. (2 m) of yarn remains.

Bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

st(s) = stitch(es)
