SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 27 x 64 in. (68.5 x 162.5 cm) at longest and widest

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Mandala® (Art. #525)
 - 217 Genie 1 ball
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

GAUGE

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern Rows 1-6.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



STITCH EXPLANATION

Yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring varn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece beginning at the neck edge.
- 2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- Four yarn over increases are worked on every RS row of Shawl.

CORRECTIONS: (applied June 16th, 2017)

SHAWL

Set Up Row (RS): K2, yo, place marker, k1, place marker, yo,

k2 – at the end of this row you will have 7 sts.

Next Row: Slipping markers as you come to them, k2, purl to

last 2 sts, k2.

SHAWL

Cast on 5 sts. Knit 2 rows.

Set Up Row (RS): K2, yo, place marker, k1, place marker, yo, k2 – at the end of this row you will have 7 sts.

Next Row: Slipping markers as you come to them, k2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 1 (Increase Row, RS): K2, yo, k to marker, yo, slip marker, k1, slip marker, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

Rows 2 and 4: Slipping markers as you come to them, k2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Rows 3 and 5: Repeat Row 1.

Row 6 (WS): Slipping markers as you come to them, knit across.

Repeat Rows 1 - 6 until piece along center st between markers measures about 25 1/2 in. (65 cm), end with a Row 6 as the last row you work.

Border

Next Row: K2, yo, k to marker, yo, slip marker, k1, slip marker, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

Next Row (WS): Slipping markers as you come to them, knit across.

Repeat last 2 rows 3 more times - total of 8 rows worked for border. Bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit p = purl RS= right side st(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side
