# SKILL LEVEL – Easy

# <u>SIZE</u>

Finished Circumference About 20 in. (51 cm) Finished Height About 6 in. (15 cm)

## MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Fast-Track® (Art. #521)
  - 157 Taxi Cab Yellow 1 skein
  - 108 Dune Buggy Denim 1 skein
  - 146 Purple Train 1 skein
  - 100 Airstream White 1 skein
  - 149 Chopper Grey 1 skein
  - 130 Go Kart Green 1 skein
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

# <u>GAUGE</u>

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.

## **NOTES**

- 1. Materials are sufficient to make multiple Baskets.
- 2. Baskets are worked in the round, handles are worked directly onto Baskets.
- 3. General instructions are given, get creative when you make your Baskets! We made ours with varying stripe patterns. Use yarn colors as you like!

# **BASKETS**

Ch 11.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 8 ch, 4 sc in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 8 ch, 2 sc in next ch; join with sl st in first sc – you will have 24 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st; join with sl st in first sc -28 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next 4 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next 4 sts, hdc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next 4 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next st, s

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, 2 sc in same st as joining, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st; join with sl st in first sc -40 sts.



**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each st around; do not join, begin working in continuous rnds (spiral). Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 6: Working in back loops only, sc in each st around.

**Rnd 7:** Working in back loops only, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 15 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 15 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st -44 sts.

**Rnds 8 and 9:** Working in back loops only, sc in each st around. At end of Rnd 9; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

#### Handles

Mark center st at each narrow end of Basket. From RS, join yarn with a sl st in 3rd sc before one marked center st. Ch 14, skip next 4 sc along edge of Basket, sl st in next st. Fasten off. Rep to make handle at opposite end of Basket, but do not fasten off. **Edging Rnd:** \*Sc in each st around to ch-14 handle, sl st in each of the 14 ch; rep from \* around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
