

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Jeans® Everyday Shrug Pattern Number: L70008



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 38 x 44 in. (96.5 x 112 cm), before folding and seaming

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Jeans® (Art. #505)
 - 121 Top Stitch 1 ball (A)
 - 110 Classic 5 balls (B)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 40 in. (101.5 cm) long

19 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

PATTERN STITCH

K1, p1 Rib (worked over an odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): *K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k last st.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib.

NOTES

- 1. Shrug is worked in one piece, then folded and seamed.
- 2. Shrug is stretchy and will fit a range of sizes.
- A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.

SHRUG

With A, cast on 183 sts.

Purl one row.

Beginning Rib

Change to B and, beg with Row 1, work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures about 2 in. (5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Body

With B, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 42 in. (106.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Ending Rib

Change to B and, beg with Row 1, work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures about 44 in. (112 cm) from beg, end with a RS row as the last row you work.

Change to A and purl one row. With A, bind off.

FINISHING

Fold piece in half, bringing cast-on edge to meet bound off edge so that piece measures about 38 x 22 in. (96.5 x 56 cm). Place markers on each of the 22 in. (56 cm) sides, 7 in. (18 cm) below fold for armholes. Seam each side from marker down to lower edge.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = beginning

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side
