SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

Shawl

About 28 x 56 in. (71 x 142 cm) at longest and widest

Hat

Finished Circumference at Band About 20 in. (51 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Height About 9 1/2 in. (24 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
 - 105 Glacier Bay 3 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

3 1/2 x 3 1/2 in. (9 x 9 cm) piece of cardboard (for tassels) 4 decorative buttons (3 for Shawl, 1 for Hat)

GAUGE

19 sts + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-7 of Shawl. 18 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm) in lower band of Hat. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

Beg-CI (beginning 3 double crochet cluster) Ch 3, yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook); yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

CI (3 double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), (yarn over, insert hook in *same* st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice; yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

NOTES

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece from center back neck down to lower edge.
- 2. Hat is worked in one piece from top down to band in joined rnds with RS always facing.
- 3. For those who find visuals helpful, we've included stitch diagrams. The stitch diagram for Hat begins at Rnd 5, after increases of Rnds 1-4 have been completed.

SHAWL

Make an adjustable ring, as follows: Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the sts of Row 1 into ring.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 10 dc in ring – you will have 11 dc in this row. Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Row 2: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, dc in next 4 dc, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 4 dc, ch 2, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 10 dc, 1 sc, 2 ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-2 sps.

Row 3: Ch 7 (counts as dc, ch 4), turn, sk first ch-2 sp, dc in next 4 dc, dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 9, sk next sc, dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next 4 dc, ch 4, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5 – 12 dc, 2 ch-4 sps, and 1 ch-9 sp (6 dc and 1 ch-4 sp on each side of center ch-9 sp).

Row 4: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, 5 dc in first ch-4 sp, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, (4 dc, ch 3, sc, ch 3, 4 dc) in center ch-9 sp, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, 5 dc in beg ch-sp, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-7 – 20 dc, 3 sc, 6 ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-2 sps.

Row 5: Ch 7 (counts as dc, ch 4), turn, sk first ch-2 sp, dc in next 5 dc, ch 5, sk next sc, dc in next 4 dc, dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 9, sk next sc, dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next 4 dc, ch 5, sk next sc, dc in next 5 dc, ch 4, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5 – 22 dc, 2 ch-4 sps, 2 ch-5 sps, and 1 ch-9 sp (11 dc, 1 ch-4 sp and 1 ch-5 sp on each side of center ch-9 sp).

Row 6: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, *5 dc in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk next 2 dc; rep from * to center ch-9 sp, (4 dc, ch 3, sc, ch 3, 4 dc) in center ch-9 sp, **ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, 5 dc in next ch-sp; rep from ** across working last 5 dc in beg ch-sp, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-7 – 30 dc, 5 sc, 10 ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-2 sps.

Row 7: Ch 7 (counts as dc, ch 4), turn, sk first ch-2 sp, *dc in next 5 dc, ch 5, sk next sc; rep from * to 4 dc before center sc, dc in next 4 dc, dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 9, sk next sc, dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next 4 dc, **ch 5, sk next sc, dc in next 5 dc; rep from ** to beg ch-sp, ch 4, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5 – 32 dc, 2 ch-4 sps, 4 ch-5 sps, and 1 ch-9 sp (16 dc, 1 ch-4 sp and 2 ch-5 sps on each side of center ch-9 sp).

Rows 8-37: Rep Rows 6 and 7 for 15 more times – 182 dc, 2 ch-4 sps, 34 ch-5 sps, and 1 ch-9 sp (91 dc, 1 ch-4 sp and 17 ch-5 sps on each side of center ch-9 sp).

Row 38: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 3 dc in first ch-4 sp, dc in next 5 dc, *5 dc in next ch-5 sp, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * to center ch-9 sp, (5 dc, ch 3, 5 dc) in center ch-9 sp, dc in next 5 dc, **5 dc in next ch-5 sp, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * to beg ch-sp, 3 dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-7 – 370 dc and 1 ch-3 sp (185 dc on each side of center ch-3 sp). Fasten off.

FINISHING

Tassels (make 3)

Cut 2 strands of yarn, each about 10 in. (25.5 cm), and set aside.

Wrap yarn around cardboard about 23 times.

Thread blunt needle with one of the cut yarn strands. Insert needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard.

Wrap second cut yarn strand around loops 1 in. (2.5 cm) below top tie to form Tassel neck. Knot securely; thread ends into needle and weave ends to center of Tassel.

Trim Tassel ends evenly.

Tie a Tassel to each top point and to bottom point of Shawl. Sew a button to tie of each Tassel.

Weave in ends.

HAT

Make an adjustable ring, as follows: Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the sts of Rnd 1 into ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Beg-Cl in ring, (ch 3, Cl in ring) 5 times, ch 3; join with sl st in top of beg-Cl – you will have 6 clusters and 6 ch-3 sps.

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Rnd 2: SI st in first ch-3 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 5 dc in same ch-3 sp, 6 dc in each ch-3 sp around; join with sI st in top of beg ch-3 – 36 dc.

Rnd 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in first st, dc in next st, *2 dc in next st, dc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 54 dc.

Rnd 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next st, (2 dc in next st, dc in next st) 13 times, (dc in next st, 2 dc in next st) 13 times; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 80 dc.

Rnd 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 4 sts, *ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st, ch 3, sk next st, dc in next 5 sts; rep from * to last 3 sts, ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st, ch 3, sk last st; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – Ten 5-dc groups, 10 sc, and 20 ch-3 sps.

Rnd 6: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 4 sts, *ch 5, sk next sc, dc in next 5 sts; rep from * to last sc, ch 5, sk last sc; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – Ten 5-dc groups and 10 ch-5 sps.

Rnd 7: Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), sk next dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, *5 dc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk next 2 dc; rep from * to last ch-5 sp, 4 dc in last ch-5 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-6 – Ten 5-dc groups, 10 sc, and 20 ch-3 sps.

Rnd 8: Ch 8 (counts as dc, ch 5), sk next sc, *dc in next 5 dc, ch 5, sk next sc; rep from * to last 4 dc, dc in last 4 dc; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-8 – Ten 5-dc groups and 10 ch-5 sps.

Rnd 9: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 4 dc in first ch-5 sp, *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, 5 dc in next ch-5 sp; rep from * to last 4 dc, ch 3, sk next 2

dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk last dc; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – Ten 5-dc groups, 10 sc, and 20 ch-3 sps.

Rnds 10-13: Rep Rnds 6-9.

Rnd 14: Rep Rnd 6.

Rnd 15: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 4 dc, *4 dc in next ch-5 sp, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * to last ch-5 sp, 4 dc in last ch-5 sp; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 90 dc.

Do NOT fasten off.

Band

Rnds 16-19: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2.

Rnd 20: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), *(sc, ch 3, sc) in next st (picot made), hdc in next 5 sts; rep from * to last 4 sts, hdc in last 4 sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – 15 picots and 75 hdc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew a button to Hat band as desired.

Weave in ends.
