

# Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Pom-Pom Scarf

## SKILL LEVEL – 3

## SIZE

About 7 x 52 in. (18 x 132 cm)

## **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® (Art. #620)
  - 098 Natural Heather 2 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® Pom-Pom Maker
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



## **GAUGE**

4 shells = about 5 in. (12.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

# **STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

dc2tog (double crochet 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

**dc4tog (double crochet 4 sts together)** (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops) 4 times, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 3 sts decreased.

shell (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in indicated st or sp.

#### NOTES

- 1. Scarf is crocheted in one piece in easy stitch patterns.
- 2. A stitch diagram is included to clarify the written instructions.
- 3. Four pom-poms are made, then one is tied to each corner of the Scarf.

# **SCARF**

Ch 30.

**Row 1:** Shell in 7th ch from hook (6 skipped ch count as 3 base ch and first dc), \*sk next 4 ch, shell in next ch; rep from \* to last 3 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in last ch – you will have 5 shells and 1 dc at beg and end of this row.

**Rows 2-10:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, shell in ch-1 sp of each shell, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 11:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 4 dc in ch-1 sp of first shell, \*dc in next sp between shells, 4 dc in ch-1 sp of next shell; rep from \* to beg ch, dc in top of beg ch – Five 4-dc groups and 6 dc.

**Row 12:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, dc4tog, \*ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc4tog; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch – 5 dc4tog, 6 dc, and 10 ch-1 sps.

Row 13: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first dc, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc4tog, \*sk next ch-1 sp, 4 dc in next dc, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc4tog; rep

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from \* to beg ch-sp, 2 dc in 3rd ch of beg ch – Four 4-dc groups, 5 dc, and one 2-dc group at beg and end of row.

**Row 14:** Ch 2, turn, dc in next dc (beg ch-2 and following dc count as first dc2tog), ch 1, dc in next dc, \*ch 1, dc4tog, ch 1, dc in next dc; rep from \* to last 2 dc, ch 1, dc2tog – 4 dc4tog, 5 dc, 2 dc2tog, and 10 ch-1 sps.

**Row 15:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first ch-1 sp, 4 dc in next dc, \*sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc4tog, sk next ch-1 sp, 4 dc in next dc; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, sk last ch-1 sp, dc in last dc – Five 4-dc groups and 6 dc.

Rep Rows 12-15 until piece measures about 45 in. (114.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 12 as the last row you work.

**Next Row:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first ch-1 sp, shell in next dc4tog, \*sk next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, sk next ch-1 sp, shell in next dc4tog; rep from \* to beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch - 5 shells and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

Last 9 Rows: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, shell in ch-1 sp of each shell, dc in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

Following package directions, make 4 medium size pom-poms. Tie one pom-pom to each corner of Scarf.

Weave in ends.

ch = chain
ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made
dc = double crochet
rep = repeat
sk = skip
sp = space
st(s) = stitch(es)
