

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Jeans® Two Color Hat and Tied Scarf

Pattern Number: L70011
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SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

Scarf

Triangle is about 12 in. (30.5 cm) long, tie about 50 in. (127 cm) long Hat

Finished Circumference About 19 in. (48.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Jeans® (Art. #505)
 - 105 Faded 1 ball (A)
 - 109 Stonewash 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® Pom-Pom Maker
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

17 sc-blo + 17 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

sc-blo (single crochet in back loop only) Insert hook in back loop only of indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook. sc2tog-blo (sc 2 sts together in back loops only) (Insert hook in back loop only of next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

- 1. Scarf is worked in 2 steps with 2 colors of yarn. First a tie is worked back and forth in rows. Then, stitches are worked along one long edge of tie to begin the triangle section.
- Hat is worked in 2 steps with 2 colors of yarn. First the Hat is worked back and forth in rows. Then, stitches are worked across one long edge of the Hat to begin the lower band. Hat is then sewn together and a pom-pom is tied on.
- To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color.
- 4. Diagrams are provided to clarify the construction of the Hat and Scarf.

SCARF

With A, ch 11.

Tie

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 10 sc at the end of Row 1.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc-blo in each st to last st, sc in last st.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 25 in. (63.5 cm) from beg, change to B in last st of last row.

Fasten off A.

With B, rep Row 2 until piece measures about 50 in. (127 cm) from beg. Fasten off.

Scarf Triangle

Note: When changing yarn color, do not fasten off old color until instructed. Drop old color to back of piece and pick it up again when next needed.

Place tie onto a flat surface with one long edge at top, A-colored half to your right and B-colored half to your left (if you crochet left-handed, place A-colored half to your left and B-colored half to your right).

Place 2 markers on top edge, each about 8 in. (20 cm) from center of tie (color change is center of tie).

Row 1: From RS, join B with a sl st at first marker (in A-colored section), ch 1, work 33 sc evenly spaced along edge to center of tie; change to A and work 33 sc evenly spaced along edge to second marker – 66 sc. Remove markers.

Row 2 (Decrease Row): With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc2tog-blo, sc-blo in each st to center; change to B, sc-blo in each st to last 3 sts, sc2tog-blo, sc in last st – 64 sc.

Row 3 (Decrease Row): With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc2tog-blo, sc-blo in each st to center; change to A, sc-blo in each st to last 3 sts, sc2tog-blo, sc in last st -62 sc.

Row 4 (Decrease Row): With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc2tog-blo, sc-blo in each st to center; change to B, sc-blo in each st to last 3 sts, sc2tog-blo, sc in last st -60 sc.

Row 5: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc-blo in each st to center; change to A, sc-blo in each st to last st, sc in last st.

Rows 6-41: Rep Rows 2-5 nine more times – 6 sc.

Row 42: Rep Row 2 – 4 sc.

Row 43: With B, ch 1, turn, sc2tog-blo; change to A, sc2tog-blo – 2 sc.

Row 44: With A, ch 1, turn, sc2tog-blo - 1 sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

HAT

With A, ch 31.

Row 1: With A, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across -30 sc.

Rows 2-40: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc-blo in each st to last st, sc in last st. Change to B in last st of last row.

Fasten off A.

Rows 41-80: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc-blo in each st to last st, sc in last st.

Do NOT fasten off.

Band

Row 1 (RS): With B, ch 1, do not turn, work 80 sc evenly spaced in ends of rows along side edge – 80 sc.

Rows 2-9: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc-blo in each st to last st, sc in last st.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

FINISHING

With yarn tail, sew edges of band together, then sew first and last rows of Hat together.

Thread yarn tail in and out through ends of rows around top of Hat. Pull yarn tail to close opening at top of Hat and knot securely.

Pom-pom

With A, and following package directions, make a medium size pom-pom. Tie pom-pom to Hat.

Weave in yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s) ch = chain rep = repeat RS = right side sc = single crochet sl st = slip st st(s) = stitch(es)
