

# Free Crochet Pattern **Lion Brand® Landscapes®** Brainbridge Cowl Pattern Number: L70030

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### SKILL LEVEL - Easy

#### **SIZE**

Finished Circumference About 54 in. (137 cm) Finished Height About 8 in. (20.5 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Landscapes® (Art. #545)
  - 209 Wild Flowers 1 ball (A)
  - 211 Coral Reef 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



#### **GAUGE**

12 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern over Rows 2 and 3. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### **NOTES**

- 1. Cowl is made in one piece with 2 colors of yarn and then seamed.
- To change yarn color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color.
- 3. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

#### COWL

With A, ch 24.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* across – you will have 12 sc and 11 ch-1 sps in this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in each ch-1 sp across, dc in last sc – Eleven 2-dc groups and a dc at beg and end of row.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sp between sts (before first 2-dc group), \*ch 1, sc in next sp between 2-dc groups; rep from \* across working last sc in sp following last 2-dc group (before beg ch-3) – 12 sc and 11 ch-1 sps.

With A, rep Rows 2 and 3 until there is not enough A remaining to work another row. Change to B in last st of last A row.

With B, continue to rep Rows 2 and 3 until almost all of B has been used, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

#### **FINISHING**

With yarn tail, sew ends of rectangle together to make the Cowl. Weave in ends.
