SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZES

6 Months (1 yr, 2-3 yrs, 4 yrs)

Finished Chest About 19 1/2 (21 1/4, 23, 25) in. (49.5 (54, 58.5, 63.5) cm)

Finished Length About 9 1/2 (10, 11, 12) in. (24 (25.5, 28, 30.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Jeans® (Art. #505)
 - 110 Classica 1, (1, 1, 2) ball(s) (A)
 - 105 Faded 2, (2, 3, 4) balls (B)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch holders
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

2 buttons, 1/2 in. (13 mm) diameter

Sewing needle and thread

3 in. (7.5 cm) piece of cardboard

GAUGE

18 sts + 32 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every stitch of every row).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left-hand needle, then knit through back of same st – 1 st increased.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small hole in the knitting, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right-hand needle. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed. In this pattern, the yarn over creates a buttonhole.

NOTES

1. Hoodie is knit in one piece from lower edge to armholes, then divided at armholes and fronts and back are worked separately.
2. Sleeves and Hood are knit separately and sewn to the Hoodie.

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HOODIE

Body

With A, cast on 88 (96, 104, 112) sts.

Knit 8 rows.

Change to B.

Continue in Garter st (k every row) until piece measures about 4 1/2 (5, 5 1/2, 6) in. (11.5 (12.5, 14, 15) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Note: Garter st is a reversible st, just choose the side you prefer to be the WS.

Divide for Fronts and Back

Next Row (RS): K23 (25, 27, 29) sts and place these sts on a holder for right front; k42 (46, 50, 54) sts and place these sts on a second holder for back, k to end of row – you will have 23 (25, 27, 29) sts rem on needle for left front.

Left Front

Continue in Garter st with B on left front sts only until left front measures about 3 (3, 3 1/2, 4) in. (7.5 (7.5, 9, 10) cm) from dividing row, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Next Row (Buttonhole Row): K to last 5 sts, k2tog, yo, k3.

Knit 5 rows.

Rep Buttonhole Row once more.

Knit 2 rows.

Shape Neck

Next Row (WS): Bind off 12 (14, 16, 18) sts, k to end of row.

Continue in Garter st over rem 11 sts until left front measures about 5 (5, 5 1/2, 6) in. (12.5 (12.5, 14, 15) cm) from dividing row.

Bind off.

Back

Slip sts for back from holder back to needle so that you are ready to work a WS row. Join B and continue in Garter st until back measures same length as left front.

Bind off.

Right Front

Slip sts for right front from holder back to needle so that you are ready to work a WS row. Join B and continue in Garter st until right front measures same length as left front to neck, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

Next Row (RS): Bind off 12 (14, 16, 18) sts, k to end of row.

Continue in Garter st over rem 11 sts until right front measures same length as left front.

Bind off.

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SLEEVES (make 2)

Notes

1. The Sleeves are worked in Garter st, changing yarn color to make stripes.
2. The stripes are made by working 8 rows each with A and B alternately. You don't need to cut the unused yarn color – just carry it along the side edge of the Sleeve.
3. The Hoodie shown was made in the 1 year size. If you're making a different size, your Sleeves will end with a stripe of yarn color B instead of the color A shown.

With A, cast on 25 (25, 27, 29) sts.

Knit 3 (4, 5, 6) rows.

Next (Increase) Row: K1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – you will have 27 (27, 29, 31) sts at the end of this row.

Remembering to change yarn color so that you work 8 rows each with A and B, rep last 4 (5, 6, 7) rows until you have 41 (43, 45, 49) sts.

Continue in Garter st, continuing to change yarn color until you have completed 6 (7, 8, 10) stripes – Sleeve should measure about 6 (7, 8, 10) in. (15 (18, 20.5, 25.5) cm) from beg.

Bind off.

HOOD

With A, cast on 68 (72, 77, 81) sts.

Knit 8 rows.

Change to B and continue in Garter st until piece measures 6 (6 1/2, 7, 8) in. (15 (16.5, 18, 20.5) cm) from beg.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew Sleeve seams, then sew Sleeves into armholes.

Fold Hood in half and sew bound-off edge together for back of Hood.

Sew Hood to neck edge of Hoodie.

With sewing needle and thread, sew buttons to right front, opposite buttonholes.

Weave in ends.

Tassel

Cut a 20 in. (51 cm) length of A and thread into blunt needle. Set aside.

Wrap A around cardboard about 20 times. Insert threaded needle under all strands at one edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot.

With crochet hook, chain the remaining length of tied strand, then fasten off.

Cut yarn loops at opposite edge of cardboard.

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Cut a 6 in. (15 cm) strand of A and wrap tightly around loops 1 in. (2.5 cm) below top knot. Knot securely; then thread ends into needle and weave to center of tassel.

With crochet hook, draw crochet chain on tassel through tip of hood to WS. Knot chain on inside of the hood. Trim tassel ends evenly.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

rem = remain(ing)

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
