## **SKILL LEVEL** – Beginner

### **SIZE**

**Finished Circumference** About 20 1/2 in. (52 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Hometown USA® (Art. #135)
  - 317 Carson City Tweed 2 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size P-15 (10 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

7 sts = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm) over Row 2 of pattern.  
**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **NOTES**

1. Hat is worked as a rectangle, back and forth in rows, then seamed.
2. Stitches of the last row are gathered for top of Hat.
3. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

### **HAT**

Ch 34.

**Row 1:** Sc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), \*dc in next ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* across – you will have 16 dc and 16 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, skip first sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* to beg ch, sc in top of beg ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 13 in. (33 cm) from beg.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then through sts of last row. Pull tail to gather top of Hat.

Sew sides together for back seam of Hat.

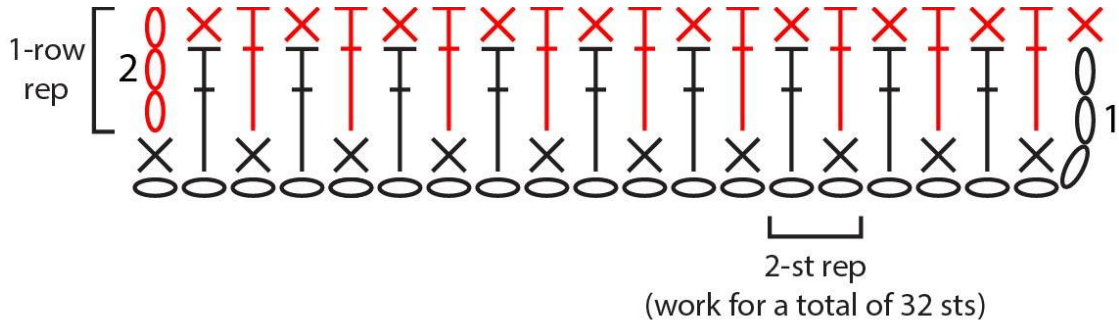
### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

dc = double crochet  
rep = repeat  
sc = single crochet  
st(s) = stitch(es)
