SKILL LEVEL – Intermediate

SIZE

ONE SIZE

Finished Lower Edge Width About 13 in. (33 cm)

Finished Upper Edge Width About 18 in. (45.5 cm)

Finished Hood Height About 13 in. (33 cm)

Finished Length About 34 in. (86.5 cm), including hood

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® New Basic 175® (Art. #675)
 - 152 Charcoal 3 balls
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® stitch holders
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

16 sts + 19 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

22 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in K1, p1 Rib.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

M1 (make 1) An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop – 1 st increased.

pfb (purl into front and back) Purl next st without removing it from the left hand needle, then p through back of same st – 1 st increased.

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right hand needle; insert left hand needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together – 1 st decreased.

PATTERN STITCHES

K1, p1 Rib (worked over an odd number of sts)

Row 1: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib worked over an odd number of sts.

K1, p1 Rib (worked over an even number of sts)

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib worked over an even number of sts.

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NOTES

1. Hood is worked in one piece beginning at lower front edge. At upper front the piece is divided for front opening, then re-joined to work back of hood.
2. The top of hood is shaped using short rows. Short rows are rows that are worked over a portion of the sts in a row, leaving the remaining sts unworked. To work short rows, the pattern instructions will tell you to 'turn' before you reach the end of the row.

Note: The following corrections have been incorporated into the pattern below. We are highlighting the corrections separately here so that if you have printed out an earlier version of the pattern you'll know what was changed.

CORRECTIONS (applied Sept. 28th, 2017)

Join for Hood

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Rows 18 ~~20-46~~: Rep Row 2 for 29 times.

HOOD

Front

Beg at lower front edge, cast on 73 sts.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) from beg.

Shape Sides

Row 1 (RS): Work in K1, p1 Rib over first 5 sts, place marker (pm), k to last 5 sts, pm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Rows 2-8: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, slip marker (sm), work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Row 9 (Increase Row – RS): Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, k1, M1, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k1, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row – you will have 75 sts in this row.

Rows 10-33: Rep Rows 2-9 for 3 more times – 81 sts in Row 32.

Row 34: Rep Row 2.

Front Placket

Row 1 (RS): Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st over next 27 sts, pm, p1, *k1, p1; rep from * 8 more times, pm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Rows 2-6: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to next marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Row 7 (Increase Row – RS): Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, k1, M1, k to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to next marker, sm, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k1, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row – 83 sts.

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Rows 8-13: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to next marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Row 14: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 9 sts, M1, work in K1, p1 Rib to next marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row – 84 sts.

Row 15: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, k1, M1, k to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 8 sts, p2, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 8 sts, sm, ssk, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k1, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Row 16: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 8 sts, k2, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 8 sts, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Row 17: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 8 sts, p2, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 8 sts, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Rows 18-21: Rep Rows 16 and 17 twice more.

Row 22: Rep Row 16.

Row 23: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, k1, M1, k to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 8 sts, p2, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 8 sts, sm, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k1, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row – 86 sts.

Row 24: Rep Row 16.

Divide for Fronts

Left Front

Row 1 (RS): Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 8 sts, p1, place rem 43 sts on a holder for right front – 42 sts rem on needle for left front.

Rows 2-10: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Row 11: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row – 41 sts.

Rows 12-21: Rep Rows 2-11 – 40 sts in Row 21.

Rows 22-30: Rep Rows 2-10.

Place rem 40 sts on a holder.

Right Front

Return 43 right front sts from holder to needle so that you are ready to work a RS row.

Row 1 (RS): P1, continue in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, ssk, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row – 42 sts.

Rows 2-10: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Row 11: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, ssk, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row – 41 sts.

Rows 12-21: Rep Rows 2-11 – 40 sts in Row 21.

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Rows 22-30: Rep Rows 2-10.

Join for Hood

Row 1 (Joining Row – RS): Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, ssk, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of right front sts; return 40 left front sts from holder to left needle so that you are ready to work a RS row; slip first left front st to right needle and pass last st of right front over first st of left front and off needle (1 st decreased); work in K1, p1 Rib to next marker, sm, work in St st to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of left front sts – 77 sts.

Row 2: Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to next marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Row 3 (Increase Row – RS): Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to 1 st before next marker, M1, k1, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to next marker, sm, k1, M1, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row – 79 sts.

Rows 4-17: Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 7 more times – 93 sts in Row 17.

Rows 18-46: Rep Row 2 for 29 times.

Row 47 (Decrease Row – RS): Work in K1, p1 Rib to first marker, sm, work in St st to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to next marker, sm, ssk, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row – 91 sts.

Row 48: Rep Row 2.

Rows 49-66: Rep Rows 47 and 48 for 9 more times, removing markers as you work the last row – 73 sts.

Top of Hood

Row 1 (RS): Work K1, p1 Rib over first 9 sts, k23, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 9 sts, ssk, turn; leave rem sts unworked.

Row 2: Sl 1, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 9 sts, p2tog, turn; leave rem sts unworked.

Row 3: Sl 1, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 9 sts, ssk, turn; leave rem sts unworked.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until 30 sts rem.

Next Row (WS): Sl 1, work in K1, p1 Rib over next 9 sts, p2tog, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row – 29 sts.

Front Edge of Hood

Row 1 (RS): Work in K1, p1 Rib over first 8 sts, p2tog, turn; leave rem sts unworked.

Row 2: Sl 1, work in K1, p1 Rib to end of row.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until only 18 sts rem.

Graft rem sts together as follows:

Place first 9 sts on one knitting needle and the last 9 sts on a second needle. Holding the 2 needles parallel with WS of fabric together, thread blunt needle with one of the yarn ends and work as follows:

1. Insert needle as if to purl into first st on front piece. Insert needle as if to knit into first st on back piece. Pull yarn through, leaving sts on needles.
2. Insert needle as if to knit through first st on front needle and let the st drop from needle.
3. Insert needle into 2nd st on front needle as if to purl and pull the yarn through, leaving st on the needle.
4. Insert needle into first st on back needle as if to purl and let it drop from the needle.
5. Insert needle as if to knit through 2nd st on back needle and pull the yarn through, leaving st on needle.

Rep steps 2-5 until all sts have been grafted together. When finished, adjust tension as necessary.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

rem = remain(ing)(s)

rep = repeat

RS = right side

WS = wrong side
