

# Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Jeans® Toulin Scarf Pattern Number: L70079



## SKILL LEVEL - Easy

## SIZE

About 21 x 48 in. (53.5 x 122 cm), at longest and widest

# **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Jeans® (Art. #505)
  - 150 Vintage 2 balls
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



# **GAUGE**

17 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### NOTES

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece with easy increases and decreases for shaping.
- 2. Simple Garter and Stockinette stitch sections create texture on the Scarf.
- 3. Edges of the Scarf will roll slightly.

## SCARF

Cast on 3 sts.

#### Garter st increase section

The first section of the Scarf is worked in Garter st (knit every st on every row) with an increase worked on every other row.

**Set-up Row:** K1, knit into front and then back of next st (to increase 1 st), k last st – you will have 4 sts. Place a stitch marker at the end of this row to mark shaped edge of Scarf.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Knit across to last 2 sts, knit into front and then back of next st (to increase 1 st), k last st.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until you have 88 sts.

#### Center section

The center section of the Scarf is worked even (without increasing or decreasing). This creates a straight edge across the center back of the Scarf.

Work in Garter st (knit every st on every row) for about 2 in. (5 cm). The last row you work should end at the marked edge of the Scarf.

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## Next Row (WS): Purl.

Continue in Stockinette st (knit on RS, purl on WS) for about 2 in. (5 cm). The last row you work should be a WS (purl) row.

#### Stockinette st decrease section

**Next Row (RS):** Knit across to last 3 sts, k2tog (to decrease 1 st), k last st – 87

sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Repeat last 2 rows until you have 39 sts. The last row you work should be a RS (knit) row.

## Last decrease section

Next Row (WS): Knit.

**Next Row:** Knit across to last 3 sts, k2tog (to decrease 1 st), k last st.

Repeat last 2 rows until you have 3 sts.

Bind off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
RS = right side
st(s) = stitch(es)
WS = wrong side
