## **SKILL LEVEL – Beginner**

### **SIZE**

Garland can be made to any length, ours is about 3 yd. (3 m) long

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
  - 100 White 2 balls (A)
  - 139 Rose Shocking 1 ball (B)
  - 104 Pink Grapefruit 1 ball (C)
  - 159 Lemon 1 ball (D)
  - 169 Pistachio 1 ball (E)
  - 111 Sky Blue 1 ball (F)
- Lion Brand® Pom-pom Maker
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Dental Floss

### **NOTES**

1. Garland is made from Clouds (groups of pom-poms) and Rainbow Fringes.
2. Make the Garland any length you like. You can string the pom-poms and fringes with dental floss or strong cord.

### **GARLAND**

Fold one end of floss and knot to make a hanging loop.

#### **Rainbow Fringes**

For each Rainbow, cut four 12 in. (30.5 cm) strands each of B, C, D, E and F.

Hold 4 strands of B together and fold in half. Hold fold in front of floss, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop.

Continue in this way to make a fringe with C, D, E and F.

Trim ends of fringes – we trimmed ours at a diagonal.

#### **Clouds3**

Each Cloud is made from 3 pom-poms.

Following package instructions and with A, make a small, medium and large pom-pom for each Cloud.

Thread end of floss into blunt needle.

Draw needle through 3 pom-poms (we kept the largest pom-pom at the center of the group of 3).

Continue making the Garland by making 5 fringes for the next Rainbow, then making and stringing another group of 3 pom-poms for the next Cloud.

Our Garland began and ended with a Rainbow fringe and had 11 Clouds. Make your Garland to any length – add more Rainbow fringes or Clouds if you like!

When you're finished be sure to tie another hanging loop in the floss.
