# SKILL LEVEL - Beginner

# SIZE

About 12 x 24 in. (30.5 x 61 cm)

## **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
  - 149 Silver Grey 1 ball (A)
  - 158 Mustard 1 ball (B)
  - 098 Fisherman 1 ball (C)
- Lion Brand® Pom-pom Maker



# **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Three 1/4 in. (0.5 cm) diameter wood dowels, each 12 in. (30.5 cm) long

# **NOTES**

- 1. Wall Hanging is quick and easy to make.
- 2. Our pattern provides details to make the hanging as shown. We encourage you to use the pattern as a jumping off point to experiment with your own design to make a one-of-a-kind piece.

# **WALL HANGING**

Cut a 2 yd. (2 m) length of A.

Fold in half, then fold doubled strand in half again to 18 in. (45.5 cm). Knot about 1 in. (2.5 cm) below fold to make a hanging loop – you'll have 4 strands coming from the knot.

Divide strands into 2 groups of 2 strands each.

Measuring from the hanging loop knot, knot the 2 strands in each group together in 4 places as follows:

8 in. (20.5 cm) below hanging loop knot

9 in. (23 cm) below

10 in. (25.5 cm) below

12 in. (30.5 cm) below

Trim ends of yarn below the final knot on each group.

**Tip:** You can work on a flat surface to make the hanging – but you may find it easier to hang the piece for the following steps. Just use the hanging loop to hang the piece from something like a drawer knob.

Slide a dowel through the yarn strands between the first and second knots. Slide the next dowel through the strands between the second and third knots, and the last dowel through the strands between the third and fourth knots.

Cut 3 strands of A, each 40 in. (101.5 cm) long.

Hold the 3 strands together, and tie to the bottom most dowel with an overhand knot.

Repeat to make a total of 22 groups of A across the bottom dowel.

Trim ends of strands evenly.

# Tassels (make 9)

Cut 6 strands of B, each 11 in. (28 cm) long and one 18 in. (45.5 cm) strand of A. Hold 5 of the B strands together and fold in half.

Draw the A length through the fold and knot.

Wrap remaining strand of B tightly around strands about 1 in. (2.5 cm) below top fold and knot securely.

Trim tassel ends evenly.

Tie ends of the A strand to the center dowel, spacing the tassels evenly across and varying the hanging lengths.

On our sample piece, we varied the hanging lengths from 5-9 in. (12.5-23 cm).

## Pom-poms (make 7)

Following package directions, and using C for pom-poms and A for tying strand, make 7 medium pom-poms.

Tie ends of the A strand to the top dowel, spacing the pom-poms evenly across and varying the hanging lengths.

On our sample piece, we varied the hanging lengths from 2-6 in. (5-15 cm).
