

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Touch of Alpaca® Duo-Color Scarf

Pattern Number: L60219



SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

SIZE

About 7 x 60 in. (18 x 152.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Touch of Alpaca® (Art. #674)
 - 126 Wood 1 ball (A)
 - 108 Dusty Blue 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

12 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm), over Rows 6-9. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

V-st (V-stitch) (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st or sp.

NOTES

- 1. Scarf is worked, back and forth in rows, in one piece.
- 2. Rows 1-3 are set-up rows worked with A. The vertical stripes pattern begins on Row 4 and is worked with both A and B.
- 3. To create the reversible pattern of vertical V-st stripes, the yarn color is changed every row and the piece is turned ONLY at beginning of every other row. One WS row is worked with B, then a second WS row is worked with A. Then, one RS row is worked with B, then a second RS row is worked with A.
- 4. Each row of the vertical stripes pattern begins with a ch-2 and ends with an hdc. Between the beg ch-2 and ending hdc, sts are worked into the sts of the same color 2 rows below. When working in a st 2 rows below, work over the strands of the other color yarn between sts one row below.
- 5. A st "2 rows below" is in the row numbered 2 less than the row being worked. For example, if you are working on Row 6 the st "2 rows below" will be Row 6 2 = Row 4.
- 6. When the yarn color is changed, the yarn not in use is not cut. Instead, the loop is removed from hook and elongated so that it does not unravel. The dropped loop is returned to the hook when next needed.
- 7. For those who find a visual helpful, we have included a stitch diagram.

SCARF

With A, ch 23.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – you will have 22 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, *sk next 2 sts, V-st in next st; rep from * to last 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, work 2 dc in last st -6 V-sts.

Beg Vertical Stripes Pattern

Remove A-colored loop from hook and enlarge the loop or place it on a stitch marker so that it does not unravel.

Row 4 (WS): From WS, draw up a loop of B in first st of Row 3, ch 2 (counts as hdc); working in sts of Row 2, sk first skipped sc of Row 2, V-st in next skipped sc, *sk next skipped sc, V-st in next skipped sc; rep from * to last 2 skipped sts, sk last 2 skipped sts, dc in last sc (at base of beg ch of Row 3); hdc in top of beg ch of Row 3 – 6 V-sts, 2 hdc and 1 dc.

Remove B-colored loop from hook and enlarge the loop or place it on a st marker so that it does not unravel.

Row 5 (WS): From WS, pick up dropped loop of A and tighten loop onto hook, ch 2; working in sts of Row 3, dc in first st, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st of Row 3; hdc in top of last hdc of Row 4.

Remove A-colored loop from hook and enlarge the loop or place it on a st marker so that it does not unravel.

Row 6 (RS): From RS, pick up dropped loop of B and tighten loop onto hook, ch 2; working in B-colored sts 2 rows below, dc in first st, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st; hdc in top of beg ch-2 of previous row.

Remove B-colored loop from hook and enlarge the loop or place it on a st marker so that it does not unravel.

Row 7 (RS): From RS, pick up dropped loop of A and tighten loop onto hook, ch 2; working in A-colored sts 2 rows below, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st, dc in top of beg ch 2 rows below; hdc in last st of previous row.

Remove A-colored loop from hook and enlarge the loop or place it on a st marker so that it does not unravel.

Row 8 (WS): From WS, pick up dropped loop of B and tighten loop onto hook, ch 2; working in B-colored sts 2 rows below, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st, dc in top of beg ch 2 rows below; hdc in top of beg ch-2 of previous row.

Remove B-colored loop from hook and enlarge the loop or place it on a st marker so that it does not unravel.

Row 9 (WS): From WS, pick up dropped loop of A and tighten loop onto hook, ch 2; working in A-colored sts 2 rows below, dc in first st, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st; hdc in last st of previous row.

Remove A-colored loop from hook and enlarge the loop or place it on a st marker so that it does not unravel.

Rep Rows 6-9 until piece measures about 59 in. (150 cm) from beg, end with a Row 7 or 9 as the last row you work and do NOT remove A-colored loop from hook.

Next Row: With A, ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st and ch-1 sp across – 22 sc.

Last Row: With A, ch 1, turn, sl st in each st across.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

ch = chain

ch-sp = chain space previously made

dc = double crochet

hdc = half double crochet

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sc = single crochet



sl st = slip stitch

sp = space

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
