

Free Crochet Pattern **Lion Brand® Touch of Alpaca®** Dyker Heights Poncho Pattern Number: L70201

SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 21 x 52 in. (53.5 x 132 cm), before folding and seaming

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Touch of Alpaca® (Art. #674)
 - 150 Oxford Grey 1 ball (A)
 - 152 Charcoal 4 balls (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

4 (sc, 2 dc) groups + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Poncho is worked in one piece, then folded and seamed following a diagram.
- 2. To change yarn color, work to last yarn over of last st of old color. Yarn over with new yarn and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
- 3. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

PONCHO

With A, ch 69.

Row 1: Work 2 dc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as beg ch), *sk next 2 ch, (sc, 2 dc) in next ch; rep from * to last 3 ch, sk next 2 ch, sc in last ch – you will have 21 (sc, 2 dc) groups, 2 dc at beg of row and 1 sc at end of row (22 groups total).

Rows 2-14: Ch 2 (counts as beg ch), turn, 2 dc in first sc, *sk next 2 dc, (sc, 2 dc) in next sc; rep from * to last 2 dc, sk last 2 dc, sc in top of beg ch. Change to B in last st of Row 14.

Rows 15-127: With B, rep Row 2 for 113 more rows.

Row 128: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, *ch 2, sk next 2 dc, sc in next sc; rep from * across working last sc in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Following diagram, fold piece in half to measure about 21 x 26 in. (53.5 x 66 cm). Place a marker on one of the 26 in. (66 cm) sides, 12 in. (30.5 cm) from fold for neck opening. Place another marker 4 in. (10 cm) from first marker. Sew edges together between markers.

Weave in ends.
