## SKILL LEVEL – Easy

## <u>SIZES</u>

About 16 1/2 x 48 in. (42 x 122 cm), at longest and widest

## MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Touch of Alpaca® (Art. #674)
  - 150 Oxford Grey 1 ball (A)
    - 110 Navy 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



## <u>GAUGE</u>

15 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## STITCH EXPLANATION

### Yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.

2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

# **NOTES**

- 1. The Scarf is worked in one piece with 2 colors of yarn in Garter st (knit every st on every row).
- 2. The elongated triangle shape is created by working simple increases and decreases.
- 3. When you work yarn overs (yo's) you'll increase one stich on Row 1 and one stitch on Row 5. On Row 9, you'll work both a yarn over increase and a k2tog decrease so your stitch count will not change.

# SCARF

With A, cast on 4 sts. Knit 2 rows.

Row 1 (right side): K2, yo, knit to end of row – you'll now have 5 sts.
Rows 2-4: Knit.
Row 5: K2, yo, k to end of row – 6 sts.
Rows 6-8: Knit.
Row 9: K2, yo, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 – 6 sts.
Rows 10-12: Knit.

With A, rep Rows 1-12 for 7 more times. You'll have a total of 20 sts, and the last row you worked will have been a wrong side row.

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#### Stripes

**Note:** When working stripes, you'll be working 2 rows with each color of yarn. No need to cut yarn between color changes, just carry the color you're not using along the side edge of the piece.

With B, rep Rows 1 and 2. With A, rep Rows 3 and 4.

Continue in this way, repeating Rows 1-12 of pattern and alternating 2 rows of A with 2 rows of B, until you have 60 sts on your needle and have just finished working Row 8 of pattern.

Cut A.

With B only, rep Rows 9-12 of pattern, then rep Rows 1-12 once more. Knit one row, then bind off all sts loosely and as if to knit.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit k2tog = knit 2 stitches together rep = repeat st(s) = stitch(es)
