

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Touch of Alpaca™ Saugerties Cowl Pattern Number: L70202

SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 40 in. (101.5 cm) Finished Height About 9 in. (23 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Touch of Alpaca™ (Art. #674)
 - 104 Blush 2 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

2 pattern reps = about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm). **Note:** One pattern rep consists of a cluster (Cl) and the following ch-4 sp and 5 dc. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

CI (5 double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), (yarn over, insert hook in *same* st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times (6 loops rem on hook), yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

NOTES

- 1. Cowl is made in one piece and then seamed.
- 2. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

COWL

Ch 54.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), dc in next 4 ch, sk next 4 ch, Cl in next ch, *ch 4, dc in next 5 ch, sk next 4 ch, Cl in next ch; rep from * to last ch, ch 3, dc in last ch – you will have 5 clusters (Cl), five 5-dc groups, 4 ch-4 sps, 1 ch-3 sp, and 1 dc at beg and end of this row (total of 5 pattern reps).

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 4 dc in first ch-3 sp, dc in next Cl, sk next 4 dc, Cl in next dc, *ch 4, 4 dc in next ch-4 sp, dc in next Cl, sk next 4 dc, Cl in next dc; rep from * to beg ch, ch 3, dc in top of beg ch-3.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 40 in. (101.5 cm) from beg. Fasten off, and cut yarn leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and sew ends of piece together to make the Cowl.

Weave in yarn ends.

beg = begin(ning)(s)
ch = chain
ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made
dc = double crochet
rem = remain
rep(s) = repeat(s)
sk = skip
st(s) = stitch(es)
