SKILL LEVEL – Beginner

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 60 in. (152.5 cm)

Finished Height 10 in. (25.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Touch of Alpaca® (Art. #674)
 - 153 Black 1 ball (A)
 - 152 Charcoal 1 ball (B)
 - 138 Crimson 1 ball (C)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

16 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern Rows 1-4.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Cowl is worked in one piece and then seamed.
2. Unless otherwise noted, do not cut yarns between color changes, just carry unused color along side edge of piece.
3. The stitch pattern used in the Cowl is reversible. Before seaming, just choose the side you like best to be the outside of the Cowl.

COWL

With A, cast on 36 stitches.

Rows 1 and 2: With A, knit 4, *purl 4, knit 4; repeat from * across.

Rows 3 and 4: With B, repeat Rows 1 and 2.

Repeat Rows 1-4 until piece measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from beginning, end with Row 4 as the last row worked.

Cut A and join C.

Using C for Rows 1 and 2 and B for Rows 3 and 4, continue to repeat Rows 1-4 until you've worked about 40 in. (101.5 cm) from beginning, end with Row 4.

Cut B and join A.

Using A for Rows 1 and 2 and C for Rows 3 and 4, continue to repeat Rows 1-4 until you've worked 60 in. (152.5 cm) from beginning, end with Row 4.

With A, bind off.

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FINISHING

Sew ends of piece together to make the Cowl.
Weave in yarn ends.
