SKILL LEVEL – Intermediate

SIZES

XS/S (M/L)

Finished Bust About 38 (45) in. (96.5 (114.5) cm)

Finished Length About 22 (23) in. (56 (58.5) cm), not including neck edging

Note: Pattern is written for smaller size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
 - 177 Sage 2 (3) balls (A)
- Lion Brand® New Basic 175 (Art. #675)
 - 173 Thyme 2 (3) balls (B)
 - 108 Juniper 2 (3) balls (C)
 - 098 Cream 1 (2) balls (D)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® stitch holders
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 9 (5.5 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long

Circular knitting needle size 9 (5.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

GAUGE

16 sts + 20 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Rev St st (p on RS, k on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

pfb (purl into front and back) Purl next st without removing it from left needle, then p through back of same st – 1 st increased.

TECHNIQUE EXPLANATION

Cable Cast On

*Insert right needle between first 2 sts on left needle, wrap yarn and pull through (as if knitting a st), transfer new st to left needle; rep from * for desired number of sts.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

*Work 4 rows/rnds with C, 2 rows/rnds with B, 2 rows/rnds with D, 2 rows/rnds with A, and 2 rows/rnds with B; rep from * for Stripe Sequence.

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NOTES

1. Pullover is worked in one piece from the top down.
2. Neck shaping is worked first, back and forth in rows, then piece is joined and worked in the round.
3. The upper body is worked to underarms, then work is divided and sleeves and lower body are worked separately to lower edge.
4. Sleeves are worked back and forth in rows. Lower body is worked in rnds.
5. The yarn color is changed following Stripe Sequence throughout. Carry colors not in use loosely up the side edge of piece.
6. When working in rows, work back and forth in rows on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
7. When you see 'work even' in the instructions, this means to continue on in the pattern st you have established without changing the st count by increasing, decreasing, or binding off

PULLOVER

With shorter needle and C, cast on 52 (58) sts.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (RS): With C, p10, place marker (pm), p to last 10 sts, pm, p10.

Row 2: Pm on left needle, then with C, cast on 3 (4) sts using Cable Cast On, k to end of row, slipping markers as you come to them – you will have 55 (62) sts in this row.

Row 3: Pm on left needle, then with C, cast on 3 (4) sts using Cable Cast On, beg over sts just cast on, [p to 1 st before next marker, pfb, slip marker (sm), pfb] 4 times, p to end of row – 66 (74) sts.

Change to B. Continue to slip markers as you come to them.

Row 4: With B, cast on 4 (5) sts using Cable Cast On, k to end of row slipping markers as you come to them – 70 (79) sts.

Row 5: With B, cast on 4 (5) sts using Cable Cast On, p to end of row – 74 (84) sts.

Change to D.

Row 6: With D, cast on 5 (6) sts using Cable Cast On, [k to 1 st before next marker, kfb, sm, kfb] 4 times, k to end of row – 87 (98) sts.

Row 7 (RS): With D, cast on 5 (6) sts using Cable Cast On, k to end of row – 92 (104) sts.

Join to Complete Neck Shaping

Change to A.

Row 8 (WS): With A, cast on 8 sts using Cable Cast On, without working any sts TURN and spread the sts evenly along the needle – 100 (112) sts.

Cut B, C, and D.

As you beg the next rnd, join piece into a rnd by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle. Do not place beg of rnd marker now; it will be placed in the next rnd.

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Next Rnd (Increase Rnd – RS): With A, [p to 1 st before next marker, pfb, sm, pfb] 4 times, then p to 2nd marker, this marker is now the beg of rnd marker change it to a different color – 108 (120) sts.

Change to B.

Next 2 Rnds: With B, p to end of rnd.

Change to C.

Next Rnd (Increase Rnd): With C, [pfb, p to 1 st before next marker, pfb, sm] 4 times – 116 (128) sts.

Rep last 3 rnds for 12 (14) more times, continue to change yarn color following Stripe Sequence, and change to longer circular needle when sts no longer fit comfortably on shorter needle – 212 (240) sts when all increases have been completed.

Divide for Lower Body and Sleeves

Continue to change yarn color following Stripe Sequence throughout.

Next Rnd: K64 (74), remove marker, slip next 42 (46) sts onto a st holder for first sleeve, remove marker, cast on 12 (16) sts for underarm, k64 (74), remove marker, slip next 42 (46) sts onto a st holder for second sleeve, remove marker, cast on 6 (8) sts, pm for new beg of rnd, cast on 6 (8) sts for underarm, remove old beg of rnd marker – 152 (180) sts.

Lower Body

Work even in Rev St st worked in rnds (p every st on every rnd) and continue changing yarn color following Stripe Sequence until piece measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from divide.

Change to A.

Next Rnd: With A, knit.

Next Rnd: With A, *k1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep last 2 rnds for about 2 in. (5 cm).

Bind off.

Sleeves

Continue to change yarn color following Stripe Sequence. Work back and forth in rows.

Row 1 (Cast On Row – WS): Cast on 7 (9) sts; from WS, k42 (46) sts of one sleeve from holder – 49 (55) sts.

Row 2 (Cast On Row): Cast on 7 (9) sts, p to end of row – 56 (64) sts.

Row 3: Knit.

Decrease Row (RS): P1, p2tog, p to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1 – 54 (62) sts.

Next 9 (7) Rows: Work even in Rev St st worked in rows (p on RS, k on WS) for 9 (7) rows.

Next Row: Rep Decrease Row – 52 (60) sts.

Rep last 10 (8) rows for 5 (6) more times – 42 (48) sts.

Work even in Rev St st until sleeve measures about 14 in. (35.5 cm) from cast on rows, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Change to A.

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Next Row (RS): With A, knit.

Next Row (WS): With A, *k1, p1; rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows for about 4 in. (10 cm).

Bind off.

Rep for second sleeve.

FINISHING

Sew sleeve and underarm seams.

Neckband

From RS with shorter needle and A, pick up and k88 (94) sts evenly spaced around neck edge. Place marker for beg of rnd and join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle.

Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rep Rnds 1 and 2 for 4 in. (10 cm).

Bind off.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

rep = repeat

Rev St st = Reverse Stockinette stitch

rnd(s) = round(s)

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side

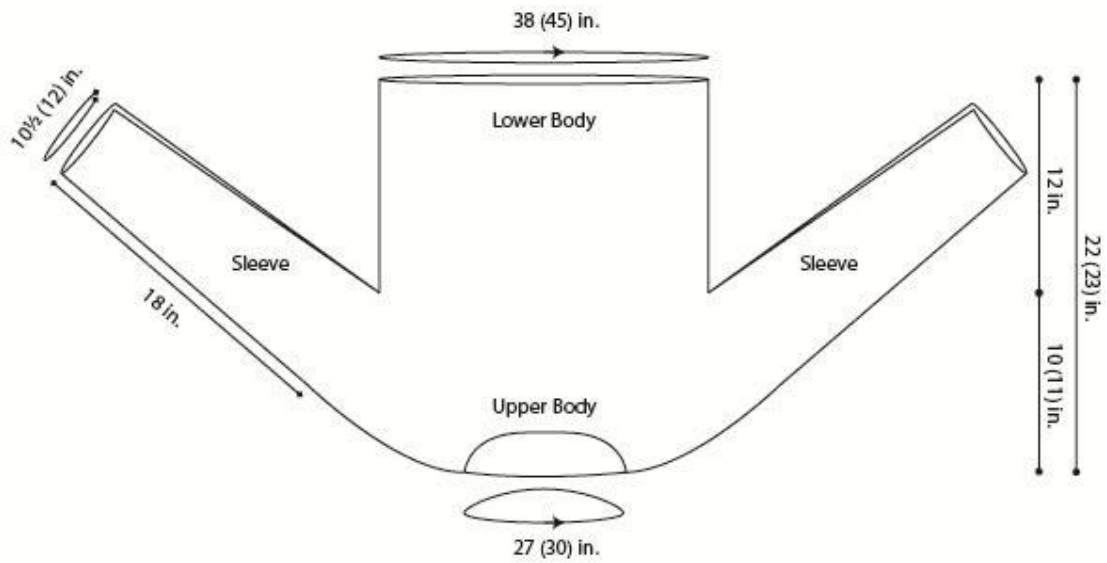
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
