

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Jeans® Tivoli Tunic

SKILL LEVEL – Easy+

SIZES

S (M/L)

Finished Bust 36 (42 1/2) in. (91.5 (108) cm)

Finished Length 33 1/2 (34 1/2) in. (85 (87.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smaller size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Jeans® (Art. #505)
 - 110 Classic 5 (7) balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

15 dc + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Tunic is worked in one piece from the top down.
- 2. From the top, Tunic is worked in the round, then divided for armholes.
- 3. Tunic is designed with side slits.
- 4. If you find it difficult to join the beg ch into a ring without twisting the ch, Rnd 1 can be worked as a row, then joined into a rnd, as follows: Leaving a long beginning yarn tail, ch 93 (97), sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; join with sl st in first sc you will have 92 (96) sc at the end of this row/rnd. Use beginning yarn tail to sew gap at base of first row closed. Proceed to Rnd 2.

TUNIC

Ch 92 (96); taking care to not twist ch, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in same ch as join, sc in each ch around; join with sl st in first sc – you will have 92 (96) sts in this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk first st, dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 3 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 4 (Increase Rnd – RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st (increase made), dc in next 29 (33) sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, place marker (pm) between the two 2-dc groups just made for back, dc in next 13 (11) sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, pm between the 2-dc groups just made for right sleeve, dc in next 29 (33) sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, pm between the 2-dc groups just made for front, dc in next 13 (11) sts, 2 dc in last st (top of beg ch-3 of previous

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rnd); join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 of this rnd, pm between last 2-dc group made and beg ch-3 for left sleeve – 100 (104) sts.

Rnds 5-12 (14) (Increase Rnds): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st, *dc in each st to 1 st before next marker, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc and move marker between the 2-dc groups just made; rep from * 2 more times, dc in each st to last st, 2 dc in last st; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 and move marker between last 2-dc group made and beg ch-3 – 164 (184) sts.

Rnd 13 (15) (WS): Ch 1, turn, *sc in each st to next marker, dc in each st to next marker; rep from * once more moving markers directly up to same place in current rnd; join with sl st in first sc - 164 (184) sts (33 (35) sc for each sleeve and 49 (57) dc each for back and front).

Divide for Back and Front

Back and front are now worked separately, back and forth in rows, beg over the dc sts of Rnd 13 (15). The sc sts of Rnd 13 (15) are skipped to form sleeves.

Back

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first dc, dc in each dc to next marker (just before first sc) remove marker; leave rem sts unworked for sleeves and front – 49 (57) dc.

Rows 2-6: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Fasten off.

Front

From RS, join yarn with a sl st in first unworked dc following next marker on Rnd 13 (15). Remove marker.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk first dc, dc in each dc to next marker, remove marker; leave rem sts unworked for left sleeve – 49 (57) dc. Remove the rem marker.

Rows 2-6: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Do NOT fasten off.

Join Front and Back at Underarms

Back and front are now joined with underarm chains and the body is worked in joined and turned rnds.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first dc, dc in each st in last row of front, ch 17 (21) for left underarm, dc in each st in last row of back, ch 17 (21) for right underarm; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 of this rnd. Fasten off.

Body

From WS, join yarn with a sl st in 9th (11th) ch of left underarm ch.

Rnd 1 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk ch in which join sl st was made, dc in each ch and dc around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 132 (156) dc.

Rnds 2-13: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first dc, dc in each dc around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 14 (Increase Rnd – RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 6 (8) sts, 2 dc in next st, pm in last dc made, dc in next 14 (16) sts, 2 dc in next st, pm in first dc of 2-dc group just made, dc in next 20 (24) sts, 2 dc in next st, pm in last dc made, dc in next 14 (16) sts, 2 dc in next st, pm in first dc of 2-dc group just made, dc in next 14 (18) sts, 2 dc in next st, pm in last dc made, dc in next 14 (16) sts, 2 dc in next st, pm in first dc of 2-dc group just made, dc in next 20 (24) sts, 2 dc in next st, pm in last dc made, dc in next 14 (16) sts, 2 dc in next st, pm in first dc of 2-dc group just made, dc in last 7 (9) sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 140 (164) dc,

Rnds 15-19: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 20 (Increase Rnd): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, *dc in each st to next marked st, 2 dc in marked st and move marker to last dc made, dc in each st to next marked st, 2 dc in marked st and move marker to first dc of 2-dc group just made; rep from * 3 more times, dc in each st to end of rnd; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 148 (172) dc.

Rnds 21-32: Rep Rnds 15-20 twice - 164 (188) dc in Rnd 32.

Remove markers.

Rnds 33-35: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Back

Back and front are again worked separately, back and forth in rows, forming side slits.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 81 (93) sts; leave rem sts unworked for front – 82 (94) sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 3 (Increase Row – RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, *dc in each st to next marked st, 2 dc in marked st and remove marker, dc in each st to next marked st, 2 dc in marked st and remove marker; rep from * once more, dc in each st to end of row working last dc in top of beg ch-3 – 86 (98) sts.

Rows 4-14: Rep Row 2 for 11 more times.

Fasten off.

Front

From RS, join yarn with a sl st in first unworked st of Rnd 35 following back.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 81 (93) sts - 82 (94) sts.

Rows 2-14: Work same as Rows 2-14 of back.

Fasten off.

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FINISHING

Armhole Edging

From RS, join yarn with a sl st anywhere in edge of one armhole.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work an even number of sc evenly spaced around armhole edge; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, *ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * to last sc, ch 1, sk last sc; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Rep around second armhole.

Neck Edging

From RS, join yarn with a sl st anywhere in neck edge.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work an even number of sc evenly spaced around neck edge; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, *ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * to last sc, ch 1, sk last sc; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Lower Edging

From RS, join yarn with a sl st anywhere in lower edge of Tunic.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work an even number of sc evenly spaced all the way around lower edge of Tunic, including slits, and working 3 sc in each corner; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, *ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * to last sc, ch 1, sk last sc; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
