# **SKILL LEVEL** – Easy+

#### SIZE

About 26 1/2 x 55 in. (67.5 x 139.5 cm) at longest and widest

## **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® LB Collection® Superwash Merino (Art. #486)
  - 141 Wild Berry 1 ball (A)
  - 145 Eggplant 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size G-6 (4.25 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

# **GAUGE**

18 dc + 9 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



### **NOTES**

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece beginning at center back neck and shaped with increases.
- To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Fasten off old color and proceed with new color.

#### SHAWL

With A, ch 7; join with a sl st in the first ch to make a ring.

**Row 1:** Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch 1 in this row and in all following rows), (7 dc, ch 2, 7 dc, ch 1, dc) in ring – you will have 16 dc, 2 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 4, turn, dc in first dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, (ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc) to center ch-2 sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 2, dc) in center ch-2 sp, ch 1, dc in next dc, (ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc) to turning ch-sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in 3rd ch of turning ch – 14 dc, 12 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp.

**Row 3:** Ch 4, turn, dc in first dc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) to center ch-2 sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 2, dc) in center ch-2 sp, ch 1, dc in next dc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) to turning ch-sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in 3rd ch of turning ch – 18 dc, 16 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp.

**Row 4:** Ch 4, turn, dc in first dc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) to center ch-2 sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 2, dc) in center ch-2 sp, ch 1, dc in next dc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) to turning ch-sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in 3rd ch of turning ch – 22 dc, 20 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp.

**Row 5:** Ch 4, turn, dc in first dc, (dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) to center ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in center ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, (dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) to turning ch-sp, dc in turning ch-sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in 3rd ch of turning ch - 48 dc, 2 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp.

**Rows 6-33:** Rep Rows 2-5 for 7 more times – 272 dc, 2 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp in Row 33.

At the end of Row 33, change to yarn B.

**Last 9 Rows:** With B, rep Rows 2-5 twice, then rep Row 2 once more – 174 dc, 170 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp in the last row worked. Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
