

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Touch of Alpaca™ Bonus Bundle® Greenpoint Cowl and Hat

SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

COWL

Finished Circumference About 28 in. (71 cm) Finished Height About 14 in. (35.5 cm)

HAT

Finished Circumference About 17 in. (43 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes Finished Height About 11 1/2 in. (29 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Touch of AlpacaTM Bonus Bundle® (Art. #124)
 - 108 Dusty Blue 2 balls
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® Pom-Pom Maker
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

20 sts = about 4 in. (20 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left hand needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

skp (slip 1, knit 1, pass slip st over) Slip 1 as if to knit, knit 1, pass slip stitch over knit stitch – 1 st decreased.

Yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

- 1. Cowl is worked in one piece and then sewn together to make a ring.
- 2. First half of Cowl is worked in an easy stitch pattern, second half is in Garter st (knit every st on every row).
- 3. Hat is worked in one piece and then sewn together.
- 4. Top of Hat is shaped with decreases, then a pom-pom is tied on.

COWL

Cast on 70 sts.

First Half

Row 1 (RS): K3, *yo, skp, k2; rep from * across to last 3 sts, yo, skp, k1. **Row 2:** P3, *yo, p2tog, p2; rep from * across to last 3 sts, yo, p2tog, p1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 14 in. (35.5 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Next Row (Decrease Row - RS): K4 *k2tog, k2; rep from * across to last 2 sts, knit last 2 sts. You'll now have 54 sts.

Second Half

Work in Garter st (knit every st on every row) until piece measures about 28 in. (71 cm) from beginning.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew cast-on and bound-off ends of piece together to make a ring, easing the cast-on edge to fit.

Weave in ends.

HAT

Cast on 80 sts.

Brim

Work in Garter st (knit every st on every row) until piece measures about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm) from beginning.

Next Row (Increase Row): K2, *kfb, k4; rep from * to last 3 sts, kfb, k2. You will now have 96 sts.

Hat

Row 1 (RS): K2, *yo, skp, k2; rep from * across to last 2 sts, yo, skp. **Row 2:** P2, *yo, p2tog, p2; rep from * across to last 2 sts, yo, p2tog.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Shape Crown (Top of Hat)

Note: The top of the Hat is worked all in Garter st, decreasing 12 sts across every RS row.

Row 1: *K2tog, k6; rep from * to end of row – you'll have 84 sts.

Row 2 and WS Rows: Knit.

Row 3: *K2tog, k5; rep from * to end of row – you'll have 72 sts.

Row 5: *K2tog, k4; rep from * to end of row – you'll have 60 sts.

Row 7: *K2tog, k3; rep from * to end of row – you'll have 48 sts.

Row 9: *K2tog, k2; rep from * to end of row – you'll have 36 sts.

Row 11: *K2tog, k1; rep from * to end of row – you'll have 24 sts.

Row 12: K2tog across.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and draw through remaining 12 sts. Pull to close top of Hat and knot.

Sew sides of piece together to make the Hat, reversing the seam along the Garter st brim.

Following package directions, make a pom-pom and tie to top of Hat.

Weave in yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit k2tog = knit 2 stitches together p = purl p2tog = purl 2 stitches together rep = repeat RS = right side st(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side
