**Lion Brand® Feels Like Butta**  
**Premie Knit Hat with Ears**  
Pattern Number: L80013



## **SKILL LEVEL – Beginner**

### **SIZES**

1 (2, 3, 4)

**Finished Circumference** About 8 (9 1/2, 11, 12) in. (20.5 (24, 28, 30.5) cm), to fit preemie about 2 lbs (4 lbs, 5 lbs, 6 lbs)

**Finished Height** About 3 1/2 (4, 4 1/2, 5) in. (9 (10, 11.5, 12.5) cm)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Feels Like Butta (Art. #215)
  - 113 Red 1 ball
- Lion Brand® double pointed knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm), set of 5
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

20 stitches + 24 rounds = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Stockinette stitch worked in rounds (knit every stitch of every round).

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **NOTES**

1. Hat is worked in one piece, from lower edge to top of Hat, on double pointed knitting needles.
2. Depending on the size Hat you make, the yarn amount is sufficient to make 4-5 Hats.

### **HAT**

Cast on 40 (48, 56, 60) stitches.

Divide stitches onto 4 needles, placing 10 (12, 14, 15) stitches on each of the needles. Place marker for beginning of round. Join by working the first stitch on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist stitches.

**Round 1:** \*Knit 2, purl 2; repeat from \* around.

**Round 2:** Repeat Round 1.

Work in Stockinette stitch worked in rounds (knit every stitch of every round) until piece measures about 3 1/2 (4, 4 1/2, 5) in. (9 (10, 11.5, 12.5) cm) from beginning.

Carefully turn Hat inside out. Divide the sts onto 2 needles, with 20 (24, 28, 30) sts on each needle. Hold these 2 needles together in your left hand.

Bind off the top of the Hat as follows:

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With a third needle, knit 2 sts together (the first st from each of the 2 needles in your left hand), repeat to knit the next 2 sts (the next st from each of the 2 needles), pass the first st on your right hand needle over the second to bind off. Continue in this way, knitting together the next st from each of the needles in your left hand, then binding off, until all sts have been bound off.

### **Ears**

Turn Hat right side out and flatten. Thread the blunt needle with a length of yarn. Sew diagonally across one top corner of Hat, about 1 in. (2.5 cm) below corner, then pull yarn gently to slightly gather the line of sewing. Bring needle to inside of Hat and knot.

Repeat on opposite top corner of Hat.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
