

# Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Mandala® Stained Glass Afghan Pattern Number: L70168

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# SKILL LEVEL - Easy

### SIZE

About 56 1/2 x 56 1/2 in. (143.5 x 143.5 cm), including borders

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Mandala® (Art. #525)
  - 209 Gnome 1 ball (A)
  - 213 Wizard 2 balls (B)
  - 204 Chimera 3 balls (C)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



# **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Circular knitting needle size 5 (3.75 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

# **GAUGE**

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## STITCH EXPLANATIONS

**M1** (make 1) An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop – 1 st increased.

**ssk (slip, slip, knit)** Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together – 1 st decreased.

### **NOTES**

- 1. The Afghan is worked in 3 steps. First, a Center Square is worked, then stitches are picked up along the sides of Center Square to make Inner and Outer Triangles.
- 2. Stitches for the borders are picked up around the outside edge of the Afghan.
- 3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.

### **AFGHAN**

### **Center Square**

With A, cast on 112 sts.

Work in Garter st (k every st on every row) until piece measures about 25 in. (63.5 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

# **Inner Triangles**

From RS with B, pick up and k112 sts evenly spaced along one outside edge of Center Square.

Row 1: Knit.

**Row 2 (Decrease – RS):** K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – you will have 110 sts in this row.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until only 6 sts rem, end with a Row 1 as the last row you work.

**Next Row (RS):** K1, k2tog, ssk, k1 - 4 sts.

**Next Row:** K1, k2tog, k1 - 3 sts.

**Last Row:** K3tog. Fasten off rem st.

In same way, pick up sts and make an Inner Triangle on each of the 3 rem sides of the Center Square.

# **Outer Triangles**

From RS with C, pick up and k166 sts evenly spaced along one edge of Center Square/Inner Triangle piece.

Work as for Inner Triangle.

Fasten off rem st.

In same way, pick up sts and make an Outer Triangle on each of the 3 rem sides of the Center Square/Inner Triangle piece.

### **FINISHING**

## First Side Border

From RS with C, pick up and k250 sts evenly spaced along one outside edge of Afghan.

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

**Row 2:** K1, M1, k to last st, M1, k1 – 252 sts. **Rows 3 and 4:** Rep Rows 1 and 2 – 254 sts.

Bind off.

Rep along rem 3 sides of Afghan. Sew side edges of borders together.

Weave in ends.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

beg = begin(ning)
k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
k3tog = knit 3 stitches together
rem = remain(ning)(s)
rep = repeat
RS = right side
st(s) = stitch(es)
WS = wrong side
