SKILL LEVEL – Intermediate

<u>SIZE</u>

About 30 x 35 in. (76 x 89 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
 - 098 Fisherman 4 balls (A)
 - 172 Kelly Green 1 ball (B)
 - 106 Aquamarine 1 ball (C)
 - 134 Terracotta 1 ball (D)
 - 109 Colonial Blue 1 ball (E)
 - 138 Rose Shocking 1 ball (F)
 - 158 Mustard 1 ball (G)
 - 192 Electric Purple 1 ball (H)
- Lion Brand® double pointed knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size G-6 (4.25 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

<u>GAUGE</u>

17 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. The Afghan is worked in one piece on a circular needle.
- 2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches.
- 3. The Afghan is worked in St st (k on RS, p on WS) and intarsia colorwork, following a chart and with Garter st (knit every st on every row) borders.
- 4. When working from chart, read RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.
- 5. The stripes on the cupcakes are worked in stranded colorwork. Use one ball of each color yarn and carry the color not in use across the WS of the work.
- 6. The bakeshop goodies are worked in intarsia colorwork. Use a separate ball of yarn for each color section and twist yarns on WS to prevent holes. Wind yarn colors D and F into 2 separate balls before beginning, also wind one ball of A into 2 separate balls. Do not carry color not in use across the WS of your work.
- 7. Teaset handles, cherries and chips are worked separately then sewn to Afghan. The sprinkles are embroidered.



AFGHAN

With circular needle and A, cast on 126 sts.

Beginning Border

With A, work in Garter st (knit every st on every row) for 8 rows.

Bakeshop Chart

Beginning with Row 1, work until all 198 rows of bakeshop chart have been completed.

Ending Border

With A, work in Garter st for 8 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Chips (make 20 – 5 for each cookie)

With crochet hook and desired yarn color(s), chain 12. Fasten off. Coil chain into a circle to make a chip. Sew 5 chips to each cookie.

Cherries (make 2)

With crochet hook and F, chain 22. Fasten off. Coil chain into a circle to make a cherry. Sew a cherry to each cupcake.

Sprinkles

With desired yarn color(s), embroider straight sts randomly over each doughnut.

Handles (make 4 – with colors as desired)

Working with 2 double pointed needles, cast on 4 sts.

Knit the sts. Do not turn work. *Slide sts to other end of needle and knit them, pulling yarn tightly across the back of the work, (do not turn work); rep from * until piece measures about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm).

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and knot securely.

Sew a handle to each teacup and teapot.

Weave in ends.


