SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 32 x 36 in. (81.5 x 91.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Feels Like Butta (Art. #215)
 - 108 Dusty Blue 2 balls (A)
 - 178 Teal 2 balls (B)
 - 100 White 2 balls (C)
 - 101 Pink 2 balls (D)
 - 140 Dusty Pink 2 balls (E)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eved blunt needle



GAUGE

4 V-sts = about 3 in. (7.5 cm).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

V-st (V-stitch) (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated stitch or space.

NOTES

- 1. Afghan is worked in one piece back and forth in rows, changing yarn color every 8 rows to make stripes.
- 2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
- 3. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

AFGHAN

With A, ch 133.

Row 1: V-st in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as 1 base ch and first dc), *sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch – you will have 43 V-sts and 1 dc at beg and end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st across, dc in top of beg ch.

Rows 3-80: Rep Row 2 changing yarn color as follows: Work 6 more rows with A, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C, 8 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 8 rows with A, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C, 8 rows with D, and 8 rows with E.

Last Row: Continuing with E, ch 1, turn, slip st in each st and ch-1 sp across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ch = chain
ch-sp = chain space previously made
dc = double crochet
rep = repeat
sk = skip
sp = space
st(s) = stitch(es)
