SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

About 15 in. (38 cm) long, not including ears

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Baby Soft® Boucle (Art. #918)
 - 144 Lavender 1 ball
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size N-13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Small amount of black yarn for face Small amount of fiberfill stuffing

GAUGE

7 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm) with larger hook. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

sc3tog (sc 3 sts together) (Insert hook in next st or ch-1 sp and draw up a loop) 3 times, yarn and draw through all 4 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased.

NOTES

- 1. Blankie is worked in one piece. The Blankie is worked diagonally beginning at lower corner. The bunny head is worked in continuous rounds (spiral).
- 2. Increases and decreases are worked to shape the Blankie.
- 3. The bunny head is worked with a smaller hook so that stuffing will not show through spaces between stitches. Ears are worked directly onto sides of top of head. The eyes and nose are embroidered onto the head.
- 4. Do not leave small children unattended with the Blankie!

BLANKIE

With larger hook, ch 2.

Increase Section

Row 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st – you will have 3 sc in this row.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st -5 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st – 6 sc and 1 ch-1 sp.

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Row 5: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st – 7 sc and 2 ch-1 sps.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st – 9 sc and 2 ch-1 sps.

Rows 7-17: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in each st to next ch-1 sp, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st - 31 sc and 2 ch-1 sps in Row 17.

Shape Paws

Row 18: Ch 15 for first paw, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 13 ch, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in each st to next ch-1 sp, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st – 47 sc and 2 ch-1 sps.

Row 19: Ch 15 for second paw, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 13 ch, [sc in each st to next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp] twice, sc in each sc across – 61 sc and 2 ch-1 sps.

Row 20: Ch 1, turn, [sc in each st to next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp] twice, sc in each st to end of row.

Row 21: Ch 1, turn, [sc in each st to next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp] twice, sc in next 3 sts; leave rem sts unworked to complete first paw – 47 sc and 2 ch-1 sps.

Row 22: Ch 1, turn, [sc in each st to next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp] twice, sc in next 3 sts; leave rem sts unworked to complete second paw – 33 sc and 2 ch-1 sps.

Decrease Section

Rows 23-27: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st, sc in each st to 1 st before next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next st, sc2tog – 23 sc and 2 ch-1 sps.

Row 28: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, sc3tog 8 times – 9 sc.

Row 29: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog - 7 sc.

Do not fasten off.

Bunny Head

Change to smaller hook.

Rnd 1: With smaller hook, ch 1, turn, working in front loops only, sc in each st across; turn to work in unworked loops along opposite side, sc in each unworked loop across – 14 sc.

Place a marker in last sc made for end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2-8: Do not turn, work in continuous rnds (spiral), sc in each st around.

Rnd 9: Sc2tog 7 times – 7 sc.

Stuff bunny head with a small amount of fiberfill.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread tail through sts of last rnd and pull to close top of head.

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Knot securely.

Ears (make 2)

With smaller hook, join yarn with a sl st at one side of top of head.

Row 1: Ch 15, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in head – 14 sc.

Row 2: Turn, sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 13 sc.

Row 3: Turn, sc2tog, sc in each st across, sl st in head – 12 sc.

Row 4: Turn, sc in each st to last 4 sts, sl st in each of last 4 sts – 8 sc.

Fasten off.

Rep on other side of head to make a second Ear.

FINISHING

With black yarn and following diagram, embroider straight st eyes, nose and mouth.

Tie each paw into a knot.

Weave in ends.
