# **SKILL LEVEL** – Easy+

## SIZE

About 48 x 52 in. (122 x 132 cm)

# **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® New Basic 175 (Art. #675)
  - 126 Espresso 3 balls (A)
  - 124 Camel 1 ball (B)
  - 173 Thyme 1 ball (C)
  - 108 Juniper 2 balls (D)
  - 172 Grass 1 ball (E)
  - 109 Petrol Blue 1 ball (F)
  - 148 Turquoise 1 ball (G)
  - 174 Olive 1 ball (H)
  - 123 Café Au Lait 1 ball (I)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



# **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Circular knitting needle size 9 (5.5 mm), 40 in. (101.5 cm) long

## **GAUGE**

14 sts + 32 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## PATTERN STITCH

Slip Stitch Pattern (worked over 17 sts)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: K2, (sl 1 wyif, k3) 3 times, sl 1 wyif, k2.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Row 5: Knit.

**Row 6:** K4, (sl 1 wyif, k3) twice, sl 1 wyif, k4.

Rows 7 and 8: Rep Rows 5 and 6. Rep Rows 1-8 for Slip Stitch pattern.

#### NOTES

- 1. Nine Strips are worked separately, then sewn together following a diagram.
- 2. Each Strip consists of 10 blocks of color worked in Slip Stitch pattern and separated by rows of Garter st. A Garter st edging is worked along Strips for borders and to separate the Strips.
- A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts in the edging. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- 4. With yarn in front (wyif) refers to the side of the work facing you as you work the row. To move yarn from front to back or back to front, bring yarn

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between needles. Take care not to wrap yarn over a needle, this could create an additional st.

## STRIP 1

With A, cast on 17 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every st on every row) for 3 rows.

**Rows 1-32:** With E, beginning with Row 1 (RS) of pattern, work in Slip Stitch pattern for 32 rows.

Rows 33-36: With A, work in Garter st for 4 rows.

Rep Rows 1-36, using C for Rows 1-32.

Rep Rows 1-36, using D for Rows 1-32.

Rep Rows 1-36, using F for Rows 1-32.

Rep Rows 1-36, using B for Rows 1-32.

Rep Rows 1-36, using H for Rows 1-32.

Rep Rows 1-36, using D for Rows 1-32.

Rep Rows 1-36, using E for Rows 1-32.

Rep Rows 1-36, using I for Rows 1-32.

Rep Rows 1-36, using C for Rows 1-32.

With A, bind off until only 1 st remains, on right hand needle.

Cut all yarn colors, except A.

# Side Edging

From RS with A, pick up and k183 sts across long side edge of Strip – you'll have 184 sts on your needle.

Work in Garter st for 3 rows.

Bind off.

## STRIP 2

Work same as Strip 1, using H, F, G, E, D, C, F, B, D and H for Rows 1-32 and A for cast on, first 3 Garter st rows, Rows 33-36, and side edging.

Bind off with A.

#### STRIP 3

Work same as Strip 1, using I, B, D, C, G, E, D, H, F and B for Rows 1-32 and A for cast on, first 3 Garter st rows, Rows 33-36, and side edging. Bind off with A.

#### STRIP 4

Work same as Strip 1, using D, E, I, H, F, I, G, C, D and E for Rows 1-32 and A for cast on, first 3 Garter st rows, Rows 33-36, and side edging.

Bind off with A.

## STRIP 5

Work same as Strip 1, using C, H, F, B, D, H, E, I, G and C for Rows 1-32 and A for cast on, first 3 Garter st rows, Rows 33-36, and side edging. Bind off with A.

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### STRIP 6

Work same as Strip 1, using B, D, G, I, E, C, D, F, H and D for Rows 1-32 and A for cast on, first 3 Garter st rows, Rows 33-36, and side edging. Bind off with A.

#### STRIP 7

Work same as Strip 1, using H, C, E, D, F, G, B, C, E and I for Rows 1-32 and A for cast on, first 3 Garter st rows, Rows 33-36, and side edging. Bind off with A.

## STRIP 8

Work same as Strip 1, using F, D, G, H, B, C, E, I, G and F for Rows 1-32 and A for cast on, first 3 Garter st rows, Rows 33-36, and side edging.

Bind off with A.

#### STRIP 9

Work same as Strip 1, using C, H, F, I, E, H, D, B, C and E for Rows 1-32 and A for cast on, first 3 Garter st rows, Rows 33-36, and side edging.

From RS with A, pick up and k184 sts evenly spaced across opposite side of Strip 9.

Work in Garter st for 3 rows.

Bind off.

#### **FINISHING**

Following diagram, sew side edges of Strips 1-9 together, in the following order: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9.

Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

wyif = with yarn in front
