SKILL LEVEL – Intermediate

SIZES

XS (S, M, L, 1X, 2X, 3X)

Finished Bust 35 (38, 42, 45, 51, 54, 58) in. (89 (96.5, 106.5, 114.5, 129.5, 137, 147.5) cm)

Finished Length 22 1/2 (23 1/2, 24 1/2, 25, 26, 26 1/2, 27) in. (57 (59.5, 62, 63.5, 66, 67.5, 68.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
 - 158 Yellowstone 4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 7, 7) balls
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® cable needle
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long Circular knitting needle size 9 (5.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long 7 buttons, 7/8 in. (22 mm) diameter

GAUGE

16 sts + 22 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with larger needles.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

1/1 LC (1 over 1 left cross) Slip 1 st to cable needle and hold in front, k1, then k1 from cable needle.

1/1 RC (1 over 1 right cross) Slip 1 st to cable needle and hold in back, k1, then k1 from cable needle.

vo (varn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative eyelet or buttonhole in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

PATTERN STITCHES

Honeycomb Cable (worked over 8 sts)

Row 1 (RS): P2, 1/1 RC, 1/1 LC, p2.

Row 2: K2, p4, k2.

Row 3: P2, 1/1 LC, 1/1 RC, p2.

Row 4: K2, p4, k2.

Rep Rows 1-4 for Honeycomb Cable pattern.

K2, p2 Rib (worked over a multiple of 4 sts + 2 additional sts)

Row 1 (RS): K2, *p2, k2; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K2, p2 Rib.

NOTES

- 1. Cardigan is worked in 5 pieces: Back, 2 Fronts and 2 Sleeves.
- 2. Pieces are seamed along raglans, then stitches are picked up for neckband and front bands.
- 3. The Honeycomb Cable pattern can be worked following written instructions or reading chart. Read RS rows of chart from right to left and WS rows from left to right.
- 4. When you see 'work in pattern as established' in the instructions, this means to work the next row of the pattern sts, lining up sts as in previous rows.

BACK

With smaller needle, cast on 70 (74, 82, 90, 102, 106, 114) sts.

Work in K2, p2 Rib until piece measures about 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Change to larger needle.

Beg with a RS row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 15 in. (38 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Ragian Armholes

Row 1 (RS): Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 8) sts, k to end of row – you will have 67 (71, 78, 86, 97, 101, 106) sts in this row.

Row 2: Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 8) sts, p to end of row – 64 (68, 74, 82, 92, 96, 98) sts.

Row 3 (Decrease Row): K1, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, k to last 7 sts, k2tog tbl, k1, yo, k1, k2tog tbl, k1 – 62 (66, 72, 80, 90, 94, 96) sts.

Row 4: Purl.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 for 7 (9, 10, 14, 20, 22, 23) more times – 48 (48, 52, 52, 50, 50, 50) sts.

Next Row (RS): K1, k2tog, k1, yo, k to last 4 sts, yo, k1, k2tog tbl, k1.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: Rep Row 3 (Decrease Row) – 46 (46, 50, 50, 48, 48, 48) sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows 4 (4, 5, 4, 2, 2, 2) more times – 38 (38, 40, 42, 44, 44, 44) sts when all decreases have been completed.

Next Row (RS): K1, k2tog, k1, yo, k to last 4 sts, yo, k1, k2tog tbl, k1.

Work even in St st for 3 rows. Bind off.

LEFT FRONT

With smaller needle, cast on 31 (35, 39, 43, 47, 51, 56) sts.

Row 1 (RS): Work Row 1 of K2, p2 Rib to last st, k1.

Row 2: K1, work Row 2 of K2, p2 Rib to end of row.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work and increase 1 (0, 0, 0, 1, 1, 1) st(s) at the end of last row - 32 (35, 39, 43, 48, 52, 57) sts. **Note:** When you see '0' in an instruction, this means that for that size, you should not work any sts, just skip to the next part of the instruction.

Change to larger needle.

Next Row (RS): K to last 9 sts, p2, (kfb) twice, p2, k3 – 34 (37, 41, 45, 50, 54, 59) sts.

Next Row: K1, p2, place marker (pm), k2, p4, k2, pm, p to end of row.

Beg Honeycomb Cable Pattern

Row 1 (RS): K to first marker, slip marker (sm), work Row 1 of Honeycomb Cable pattern over next 8 sts, sm, k3.

Row 2: K1, p2, sm, work Row 2 of Honeycomb Cable pattern over 8 sts between markers, sm, p to end of row.

Row 3: Work in St st to first marker, sm, work next row of Honeycomb Cable pattern to next marker, sm, k3.

Row 4: K1, p2, sm, work next row of Honeycomb Cable pattern to next marker, sm, work in St st to end of row.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 until piece measures about 15 in. (38 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Ragian Armhole

Row 1 (RS): Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 8) sts, work in pattern as established to end of row – 31 (34, 37, 41, 45, 49, 51) sts.

Row 2: K1, work in pattern as established to end of row.

Row 3 (Decrease Row): K1, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, work in pattern as established to end of row – 30 (33, 36, 40, 44, 48, 50) sts.

Row 4: K1, work in pattern as established to end of row.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 for 6 (8, 9, 13, 19, 21, 22) more times – 24 (25, 27, 27, 25, 27, 28) sts when all decreases have been completed.

Next Row (RS): K1, k2tog, k1, yo, work in pattern as established to end of row.

Next Row: K1, work in pattern as established to end of row.

Next Row: Rep Row 3 (Decrease Row) – 23 (24, 26, 26, 24, 26, 27) sts.

Next Row: K1, work in pattern as established to end of row.

Rep last 4 rows 3 (3, 4, 3, 1, 1, 1) more time(s) – 20 (21, 22, 23, 23, 25, 26) sts.

Next Row: K1, k2tog, k1, yo, work in pattern as established to end of row.

Next Row: K1, work in pattern as established to end of row.

Next Row: Rep Row 3 (Decrease Row) – 19 (20, 21, 22, 22, 24, 25) sts.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (WS): Bind off 11 (12, 13, 13, 15, 16) sts, work in pattern as established to end of row -8 (8, 8, 9, 9, 9, 9) sts.

Row 2: K1, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, work in pattern as established to end of row – 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 8, 8) sts.

Row 3: Bind off 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 3) sts, p to end of row – 5 sts.

Row 4: K1, k2tog, k1, yo, k1.

Row 5: Bind off 2 sts, p to end of row -3 sts.

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7: Purl.

Bind off.

RIGHT FRONT

With smaller needle, cast on 31 (35, 39, 43, 47, 51, 56) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work Row 1 of K2, p2 Rib to end of row.

Row 2: Work Row 2 of K2, p2 Rib to last st, k1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work and increase 1 (0, 0, 0, 1, 1, 1) st(s) at end of last row -32 (35, 39, 43, 48, 52, 57) sts.

Change to larger needle.

Next Row (RS): K3, p2, (kfb) twice, p2, k to end of row – 34 (37, 41, 45, 50, 54, 59) sts.

Next Row: P to last 11 sts, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, p2, k1.

Beg Honeycomb Cable Pattern

Row 1 (RS): K3, sm, work Row 1 of Honeycomb Cable pattern over next 8 sts, sm, k to end of row.

Row 2: P to first marker, sm, work Row 2 of Honeycomb Cable over 8 sts between markers, sm, p2, k1.

Row 3: K3, sm, work next row of Honeycomb Cable pattern to next marker, sm, work in St st to end of row.

Row 4: Work in St st to first marker, sm, work next row of Honeycomb Cable pattern to next marker, sm, p2, k1.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 until piece measures about 15 in. (38 cm) from beg, end with a RS row as the last row you work.

Shape Ragian Armhole

Row 1 (WS): Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 8) sts, work in pattern as established to end of – 31 (34, 37, 41, 45, 49, 51) sts.

Row 2 (Decrease Row): Work in pattern as established to last 7 sts, k2tog tbl, k1, yo, k1, k2tog tbl, k1 - 30 (33, 36, 40, 44, 48, 50) sts.

Row 3: Work in pattern as established to last st, k1.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 6 (8, 9, 13, 19, 21, 22) more times – 24 (25, 27, 27, 25, 27, 28) sts when all decrease have been completed.

Next Row (RS): Work in pattern as established to last 4 sts, yo, k1, k2tog tbl, k1.

Next Row: Work in pattern as established to last st, k1.

Next Row: Rep Row 2 (Decrease Row) – 23 (24, 26, 26, 24, 26, 27) sts.

Next Row: Work in pattern as established to last st, k1.

Rep last 4 rows 4 (4, 5, 4, 2, 2, 2) more time(s) – 19 (20, 21, 22, 22, 24, 25) sts when all decreases have been completed.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (RS): Bind off 11 (12, 13, 13, 15, 16) sts, work in pattern as established to last 7 sts, k2tog tbl, k1, yo, k1, k2tog tbl, k1 - 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 8, 8) sts.

Row 2: P to last st, k1.

Row 3: Bind off 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 3) sts, k to end of row – 5 sts.

Row 4: P to last st, k1.

Row 5: Bind off 2 sts, k to end of row -3 sts.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: Knit.

Bind off.

SLEEVES (make 2)

With smaller needle, cast on 34 (34, 38, 38, 38, 42, 46) sts.

Work in K2, p2 Rib until piece measures about 1 1/4 in. (3 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Change to larger needle.

Knit 1 row.

Purl 1 row.

Shape Sleeve

Increase Row (RS): K2, kfb, k to last 4 sts, kfb, k3 – 36 (36, 40, 40, 40, 44, 48) sts.

Work even in St st for 5 rows.

Rep last 6 rows 7 (11, 7, 11, 13, 12, 12) more times – 50 (58, 54, 62, 66, 68, 72) sts.

Rep Increase Row – 52 (60, 56, 64, 68, 70, 74) sts.

Work even in St st for 7 rows.

Rep last 8 rows 3 (0, 3, 0, 0, 0, 0) more time(s) – 58 (60, 62, 64, 68, 70, 74) sts when all increases have been completed.

Work even in St st until piece measures 17 (17, 17, 18, 18, 18, 18 1/2) in. (43 (43, 43, 45.5, 45.5, 45.5, 47) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Raglan

Row 1 (RS): Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 8) sts, k to end of row – 55 (57, 58, 60, 63, 65, 66) sts.

Row 2: Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 8) sts, p to end of row -52 (54, 54, 56, 58, 60, 58) sts.

Row 3 (Decrease Row): K1, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, k to last 7 sts, k2tog tbl, k1, yo, k1, k2tog tbl, k1 – 50 (52, 52, 54, 56, 58, 56) sts.

Row 4: Purl.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 for 15 (15, 12, 12, 12, 12, 9) more times – 20 (22, 28, 30, 32, 34, 38) sts when all decreases have been completed.

Next Row (RS): K1, k2tog, k1, yo, k to last 4 sts, yo, k1, k2tog tbl, k1.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: Rep Row 3 (Decrease Row) – 18 (20, 26, 28, 30, 32, 36) sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows 0 (1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9) more time(s) – 18 sts when all decreases have been completed.

Next Row (RS): K1, k2tog, k1, yo, k to the last 4 sts, yo, k1, k2tog tbl, k1.

Work even in St st for 3 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew raglan seams.

Neckband

From RS with smaller needle, join yarn at beg of Right Front neck, pick up and k14 (15, 16, 18, 19, 21, 21) sts evenly spaced along neck edge to raglan seam, 12 sts evenly spaced across top of Sleeve, 36 (38, 40, 40, 42, 42, 42) sts evenly spaced across Back neck, 12 sts evenly spaced across top of other Sleeve, 14 (15, 16, 18, 19, 21, 21) sts evenly spaced along Left Front neck edge – 88 (92, 96, 100, 104, 108, 108) sts.

Row 1 (WS): K1, p2, *k2, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2: K3, p2, *k2, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until neckband measures about 1 in. (2.5 cm). Bind off in pattern.

Buttonband

From RS with smaller needle, join yarn at neck edge of Left Front, pick up and k116 (120, 124, 128, 132, 136, 140) sts evenly spaced along left front edge.

Row 1 (WS): K1, p2, *k2, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2: K3, p2, *k2, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 3-6: Rep Rows 1 and 2 for 2 more times.

Row 7: Rep Row 1.

Bind off.

Place 7 markers across buttonband, with first about 1 in. (2.5 cm) below neck edge, last about 1 in. (2.5 cm) above lower edge, and remaining 5 evenly spaced between.

Buttonhole Band

From RS with smaller needle, join yarn at lower edge of Right Front, pick up and k116 (120, 124, 128, 132, 136, 140) sts evenly along right front edge.

Row 1 (WS): K1, p2, *k2, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2: K3, p2, *k2, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 3: Rep Row 1.

Row 4 (Buttonhole Row): Rep Row 2, working a buttonhole of (k2tog, yo) opposite each marker on buttonband.

Rows 5-7: Rep Rows 1-3.

Bind off.

Sew side and Sleeve seams. Sew buttons to buttonband opposite buttonholes.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

St st = Stockinette stitch


st(s) = stitch(es)

tbl = through back loop

WS = wrong side
