SKILL LEVEL – Easy+

SIZE

About 9 x 116 in. (23 x 294.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Touch of Alpaca™ (Art. #674)
 - 126 Wood 2 balls (A)
- Lion Brand® Mandala® (Art. #525)
 - 214 Centaur 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm)

GAUGE

16 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Fisherman Rib pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

k1b (knit 1 in row below). Insert tip of right needle through center of st 1 row below next st on left needle and knit the st, slipping the st above off the needle.

p1b (purl 1 in row below) Insert tip of right needle through center of st 1 row below next st on left needle and purl the st, slipping the st above off the needle.

NOTES

1. Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows in a Fisherman Rib pattern.
2. Every odd-numbered row of Fisherman Rib is worked with B and every even-numbered row is worked with A. Do not cut yarn between color changes.
3. Do not turn your work at the end of odd-numbered rows. Instead, slide all sts to other end of needle and work next even-numbered row with same side of work facing you. Turn your work at the end of even-numbered rows.
4. When the pattern tells you to slip a st, slip as if to knit or as if to purl, whichever look you prefer.

SCARF

With A, cast on 36 sts.

With A, purl 1 row.

Fisherman Rib pattern

Row 1: With B, sl 1, *p1b, k1; rep from * to last st, p1. Do not turn work. Just slide the sts to the other end of the needle so same side of work is facing you.

Row 2: With A, k1, *p1, k1b; rep from * to last st, p1. Turn work.

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Row 3: With B, sl 1, *p1, k1b; rep from * to last st, p1. Do not turn work. Just slide the sts to the other end of the needle so same side of work is facing you.

Row 4: With A, k1, *p1b, k1; rep from * to last st, p1. Turn work.

Rep Rows 1-4 until piece measures about 116 in. (294.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 4 as the last row you work.

With A, bind off as follows:

Bind off Row: With A, k1, p1; on right hand needle, lift 2nd st from tip of needle over first st and off the needle (1 st bound-off), *k1; on right hand needle, lift 2nd st over first st and off the needle, p1; on right hand needle, lift 2nd st over first st and off the needle; rep from * until only 1 st remains on right needle. Fasten off this last st.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)
