


# Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® VANNA'S CHOICE® GRANNY SQUARE SCARF

# Pattern Number: L80058



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# **SKILL LEVEL –** EASY

# SIZES

About 14 x 63 in. (35.5 x 160 cm)

# MATERIALS

- Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Vanna's Choice<sup>®</sup> (Art. #860) 110 Navy 3 balls (A) 149 Silver Grey 1 ball (B) 158 Mustard 1 ball (C) 150 Pale Grey 1 ball (D)
- Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> large-eyed blunt needle



### GAUGE

Squares I and II = about 7 x 7 in. (18 x 18 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### NOTES

- 1. Scarf is made from 9 each of Squares I and II.
- 2. The Squares are sewn together following a diagram to make the Scarf.
- 3. Each Square is worked in joined rnds with RS always facing.
- 4. To change yarn color and join at the end of a rnd, insert hook in top of beg ch, yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the joining sl st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.
- 5. We've included stitch diagrams for Squares I and II.

#### Note:

The following corrections have been incorporated into the pattern below. We are highlighting the corrections separately here so that if you have printed out an earlier version of the pattern you'll know what was changed.

CORRECTIONS (applied June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021)

#### SQUARE II (make 9)

Make 1 Square in each color sequence.

Color Sequence #1: Work 1 rnd each with A, D, B, C, D, and A.

Color Sequence #9: Work 1 rnd each with C, B, D, A, B, and A.

#### Ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have 12 dc and 4 ch-2 sps.

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### SQUARE I (make 9 – 2 each with A, C, and D, and 3 with B)

Ch 3; join with a sl st in first ch to make a ring.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have 12 dc and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk first dc, dc in next 2 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 sp (corner made), \*dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 28 dc and 4 ch-2 sps (7 dc along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

**Rnds 3-5:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk first dc, \*dc in each dc to next corner ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 3 more times, dc in each dc to end of rnd; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3; change to A in last st of Rnd 5 (if you are already working with A, you won't need to change yarn color) – 76 dc and 4 ch-2 sps (19 dc along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

**Rnd 6:** With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), sk first dc, dc in each dc around working 3 dc in each corner ch-2 sp; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 88 dc (22 dc along each of 4 sides). Fasten off.

### SQUARE II (make 9)

Make 1 Square in each of the following color sequences:

Color Sequence #1: Work 1 rnd each with A, D, B, C, D, and A.

Color Sequence #2: Work 1 rnd each with A, D, C, B, A, and A.

Color Sequence #3: Work 1 rnd each with D, B, C, A, B, and A.

Color Sequence #4: Work 1 rnd each with B, A, C, C, D, and A.

Color Sequence #5: Work 1 rnd each with B, D, C, A, D, and A.

Color Sequence #6: Work 1 rnd each with C, A, B, D, A, and A.

Color Sequence #7: Work 1 rnd each with D, A, B, C, B, and A.

Color Sequence #8: Work 1 rnd each with B, C, A, D, C, and A.

Color Sequence #9: Work 1 rnd each with C, B, D, A, B, and A.

Ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have 12 dc and 4 ch-2 sps.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** From RS, join 2nd yarn color with a sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made); rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc again in first ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 24 dc, 4 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (2 (3-dc groups) and 1 ch-1 sp along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

Note: To maintain the square shape, join each new yarn color in a different corner ch-2 sp.

**Rnd 3:** From RS, join 3rd yarn color with a sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc again in first corner ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 36 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (3 (3-dc groups) and 2 ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

**Rnd 4:** From RS, join 4th yarn color with a sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, 3 dc again in first corner ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 48 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (4 (3-dc groups) and 3 ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

**Rnd 5:** From RS, join 5th yarn color with a sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, 3 dc again in first corner ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 60 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (5 (3-dc groups) and 4 ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

Rnd 6: From RS, join A with a sl st in any dc, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each dc and ch-1 sp around working 3 dc in each corner ch-2 sp; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 88 dc (22 dc along each of 4 sides).

Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Following diagram and with A, sew Squares together to make the Scarf.

Weave in yarn ends.

ch = chain
ch-sp(s) = space(s) previously made
dc = double crochet
rnd(s) = round(s)
RS = right side
sk = skip
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)





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
