SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

About 44 x 55 in. (112 x 139.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homespun® (Art. #790)
 - 309 Deco 4 skeins (A)
 - 412 Pearls 4 skeins (B)
 - 311 Rococo 3 skeins (C)
 - 381 Barley 2 skeins (D)
- Lion Brand® Speed Hook (size 35/19 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

2 shells = about 5 3/4 in. (14.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Shell Work 3 dc in indicated stitch or space.

NOTES

- 1. Afghan is worked in one piece with 3 strands of yarn held together.
- 2. One yarn strand color is changed on every other row to create subtle shading.
- 3. To change color, work to last yarn over of last st of old yarn strand color. Drop the old strand and yarn over with the 2 remaining strands and the new yarn strand color held together, to complete the stitch. Cut old strand.
- 4. Crochet over cut yarn ends as you work to save weaving them in later.
- 5. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

COLOR SEQUENCE (38 rows)

Work 2 rows with 3 strands of A held tog, 2 rows with 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B held tog, 2 rows with 3 strands of B held tog, 2 rows with 2 strands of B and 1 strand of C held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand of B and 2 strands of C held tog, 2 rows with 3 strands of C held tog, 2 rows with 2 strands of C and 1 strand of D held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand of D held tog, 2 rows with 3 strands of D held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand of D and 2 strands of D and 1 strand of C held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand of D and 2 strands of C held tog, 2 rows with 3 strands of C held tog, 2 rows with 2 strands of B held tog, 2 rows with 3 strands of B held tog, 2 rows with 3 strands of B and 1 strand of A held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand of B and 2 strands of A held tog, 2 rows with 3 strands of A held tog.

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AFGHAN

With 3 strands of A held tog, ch 46.

Row 1: Shell in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as 1 base ch and first dc), *sk next 2 ch, shell in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch – you will have 14 shells with 1 dc at beg and end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in sp between first dc and first shell (first shell made), shell in each sp between shells across, 2 dc in sp between last shell and beg ch, dc in top of beg ch (last shell made) and change to 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held toq -15 shells.

Row 3 Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, shell in each sp between shells, dc in top of beg ch – 14 shells with 1 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in sp between first dc and first shell (first shell made), shell in each sp between shells across, 2 dc in sp between last shell and beg ch, dc in top of beg ch (last shell made) and change to 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B held tog – 15 shells.

Rows 5-38: Rep Rows 3 and 4 and continue to change yarn colors following Color Sequence. At the end of Row 38 do not change color or fasten off.

Row 39: Continuing with 3 strands of A held tog, ch 1, turn, sl st in each st across.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
