SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 14 x 84 in. (35.5 x 213.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Shawl in a Ball® (Art. #828)
 - 201 Restful Rainbow 2 balls
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Tunisian crochet hook size K-10 (6.5 mm)

GAUGE

16 sts + 22 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Tunisian Simple Stitch.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Shawl is worked in one piece in Tunisian crochet.
2. All rows of Tunisian crochet are worked with the RS facing at all times. Do not turn the work.
3. Each row of Tunisian crochet is worked in two passes: a forward pass and a return pass.
4. An edging is worked across each short end of the finished Shawl.

SHAWL

Ch 56.

Tunisian Simple Stitch

Foundation Row (forward pass): Insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, yarn over and draw up a loop (2 loops on hook), *keeping all loops on hook, insert hook in next ch, yarn over and draw up a loop; rep from * across—56 loops on hook.

Do not turn.

Foundation Row (return pass): Yarn over and draw through first loop (ch-1 made), *yarn over and draw through 2 loops; rep from * until 1 loop remains (this loop becomes the first st of the next row).

Do not turn.

Row 1 (forward pass): Sk first vertical bar of previous row (against edge of piece), *keeping all loops on hook, insert hook from right to left under next vertical bar, yarn over and draw up a loop; rep from * to last st, insert hook under 2 loops of the ch-1 and draw up a loop.

Do not turn.

Row 1 (return pass): Work same as Foundation Row (return pass).

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Rep Row 1 (forward and return passes) until piece measures about 84 in. (213.5 cm), being sure to have about 5 yd. (5 m) of yarn remaining.
Do not fasten off.

Edging

Row 1: Ch 1, sk first vertical bar of previous row, *insert hook from front to back all the way through the fabric to the right of the next vertical bar and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (sc made); rep from * across.
Fasten off.

From RS and working along opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with a sl st in first ch of foundation ch so that you are ready to work across the short end of the Shawl.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in same ch and in each ch across.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

st(s) = stitch(es)
