SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZES

HAT

Finished Circumference About 20 in. (51 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Height About 10 in. (25.5 cm)

WRIST WARMERS

Finished Circumference About 8 in. (20.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Length About 8 in. (20.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Scarfie® (Art. #826)
 - 207 Silver/Charcoal 1 ball
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

13 dc + 6 1/2 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Hat is worked in one piece. First half of the piece is a mitered square, the second half is a plain square worked in double crochet.
2. Short ends of piece are sewn together to make a tube. One end of the tube is gathered to make the top of the Hat.
3. Each Wrist Warmer is made from one mitered square. Edges of mitered square are sewn together, leaving an opening for thumb, to make the Wrist Warmer.

HAT

Ch 6.

First Half, Mitered Square

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as beg ch-sp) and in next 2 ch – you will have 3 dc and 1 beg ch-sp.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next 2 sts, 4 dc in beg ch-sp – 7 dc.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next 2 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next st (corner made), dc in next 2 sts, dc in top of beg ch – 10 dc and 1 corner ch-2 sp (5 dc on each side of corner ch-2 sp).

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in each st to corner ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in corner ch-2 sp, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch – 14 dc and 1 corner ch-2 sp (7 dc on each side of corner ch-2 sp).

Rows 5-16: Rep Row 4 twelve times – 62 dc and 1 corner ch-2 sp (31 dc on each side of corner ch-2 sp) at the end of Row 16.

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Second Half, Plain Square

Row 17 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in each dc to corner ch-2 sp, dc in corner ch-2 sp; leave rem sts unworked – 32 dc.

Row 18: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each st across.

Rep Row 18 until piece (including mitered square) measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from beg, end with a RS row as the last row you work.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, and sew short ends of piece together to make a tube, then weave tail in and out of sts around one edge of tube. Pull tail to close opening for top of Hat and knot securely.

FINISHING

Edging

From RS, join yarn with sc anywhere along lower edge of Hat. Work sc evenly spaced around edge, then join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

WRIST WARMERS (make 2)

Ch 6.

Rows 1-13: Work same as Rows 1-13 of Hat – you will have 50 dc and 1 corner ch-2 sp (25 dc on each side of corner ch-2 sp) on Row 13.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and sew side edges of Wrist Warmer together, leaving an opening for thumb.

Edging

From RS, join yarn with sc anywhere along one edge of Wrist Warmer. Work sc evenly spaced around edge, then join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Repeat edging around opposite edge of Wrist Warmer.

Weave in ends.
