

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Landscapes® Fan Lace Vest

SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

SIZES

Women's (Plus)

Finished Back Width About 25 (30) in. (63.5 (76) cm) Finished Back Length About 25 (30) in. (63.5 (76) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smaller size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Landscapes® (Art. #545)
 - 204 Desert Spring 4 (6) balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

2 pattern reps = about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm) in Fan Lace pattern.

Note: On RS rows one pattern rep consists of one 4-dc group and the following ch-3 sp. On WS rows one pattern rep consists of one sc and the following ch-7 sp.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

PATTERN STITCH

Fan Lace Pattern (foundation ch is multiple of 8 ch + 2 additional ch)

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *sk next 3 ch, 4 dc in next ch, ch 3, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across.

Row 2: Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), turn, sk first ch-3 sp, sc in first dc (first dc of first 4-dc group), *ch 7, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in first dc of next 4-dc group; rep from * to last 4 sts, ch 3, sk next 3 dc, dc in last sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, sk next ch-3 sp, 4 dc in next sc, *ch 3, sc in next ch-7 sp, 4 dc in next sc; rep from * to beg ch-6, ch 3, sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-6. Rep Rows 2 and 3 for Fan Lace pattern.

NOTES

- 1. Vest is made in one piece, then folded and seamed following a diagram.
- 2. Back is worked first, then fronts are worked along side edges of back.
- 3. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

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VEST

Back

Beg at top edge of Back, ch 114 (138).

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Fan Lace pattern until piece measures about 25 (30) in. (63.5 (76) cm) from beg – you will have 14 (17) pattern reps in each row.

Fasten off.

Place a marker on each side edge about 10 1/2 (14) in. (26.5 (35.5) cm) from Row 1.

Left Front

Hold Back with RS facing you and Row 1 at top.

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join yarn with sc in top left corner of Back, work (4 dc, ch 3, sc) 6 (8) times evenly spaced along edge to marker – 6 (8) pattern reps. Remove marker.

Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Fan Lace pattern for 14 1/2 (16) in. (37 (40.5) cm).

Fasten off.

Right Front

Hold Back with RS facing you and Row 1 at top.

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join yarn with sc in right side edge of Back at marker, work (4 dc, ch 3, sc) 6 (8) times evenly spaced along edge to top right corner – 6 (8) pattern reps.

Remove marker.

Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Fan Lace pattern for 14 1/2 (16) in. (37 (40.5) cm).

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold fronts over back, bringing top edges of fronts to center front. Sew about 4 (4 1/2) in. (10 (11.5) cm) of front side edges (A) to back side edges (B) following diagram, leaving openings for armholes.

Front Edging

From RS, join yarn with sc in lower right front corner, work (4 dc, ch 3, sc) 8 (9) times evenly spaced along right front edge working a 9th (10th) 4-dc group in join between right front and back, ch 3, work sc, (4 dc, ch 3, sc) 13 (16) times evenly spaced along back neck edge working a 14th (17th) 4-dc group in join between back and left front, ch 3, work sc, (4 dc, ch 3, sc) 8 (9) times evenly spaced along left front edge – 31 (36) pattern reps. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made
dc = double crochet
rep(s) = repeat(s)
RS = right side
sc = single crochet
sk = skip
st(s) = stitch(es)
