SIZES

XS/S (M/L, 1X/3X)

Finished Bust 38 (46, 54) in. (96.5 (117, 137) cm), unstretched – Tunic is very stretchy

Finished Length 29 (30, 30 1/2) in. (73.5 (76, 77.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® 24/7 Cotton® (Art. #761)
 - 100 White 7 (8, 10) balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size F-5 (3.75 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

1 Flower Square = about 5 in. (12.5 cm) across. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

2-dc CI (2 double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

3-dc CI (3 double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), (yarn over, insert hook in *same* st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice; yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

ch-4 join (chain-4 join) Ch 2, sl st in corresponding ch-4 sp of previous Flower Square, ch 2.

PATTERN STITCH

Lace Pattern

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, ch 2, sk first ch-2 sp, 2-dc Cl in next sc, *ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc; rep from * to beg ch-5, ch 2, sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5.

Row 2: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, sc in next Cl, *ch 5, sk next sc, sc in next Cl; rep from * to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in first sc. Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Lace pattern.

NOTES

- 1. Tunic Front and Back are worked separately, then seamed. Sleeves are worked directly onto the sides of the seamed Front and Back.
- A grid of Flower Squares is made for center of Front and Back. Lace pattern Neck, Sides, and Lower Edging are added to Flower Square center.
- 3. Flower Squares are worked in joined rnds with RS always facing. After the first Flower Square is made, following Flower Squares are joined to the previous Flower Squares.

BACK

First Flower Square

Ch 5; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 12 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc – you will have 12 sc in this rnd.

Rnd 2: *Ch 11, sl st in next sc; rep from * around – 12 sl sts and 12 ch-11 sps.

Rnd 3: SI st in first 5 ch of first ch-11 sp, (sI st, ch 1, sc) in next ch of same ch-11 sp, ch 4, sc in 6th ch of next ch-11 sp, ch 4, (3-dc CI, ch 4, 3-dc CI) in next ch-11 sp (corner made), *(ch 4, sc in 6th ch of next ch-11 sp) twice, ch 4, (3-dc CI, ch 4, 3-dc CI) in next ch-11 sp; rep from * 2 more times, ch 4; join with sI st in first sc – 4 (3-dc CI, ch 4, 3-dc CI) corners, 12 ch-4 sps, and 8 sc.

Rnd 4: SI st in first 2 ch of first ch-4 sp, ch 3, 2-dc CI in same ch-4 sp (beg ch-3 and following 2-dc CI count as first 3-dc CI), ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, (3-dc CI, ch 4, 3-dc CI) in next corner ch-4 sp, *ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, 3-dc CI in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, 3-dc CI) in next corner ch-4 sp; rep from * 2 more times, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4; join with sI st in first cluster -4 (3-dc CI, ch 4, 3-dc CI) corners, 16 ch-4 sps, four 3-dc CI, and 8 sc.

Fasten off.

Second Flower Square

Ch 5; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnds 1-3: Work same as Rnds 1-3 of First Flower Square.

Note: Rnd 4 is worked the same as Rnd 4 of First Flower Square EXCEPT that one side edge of Second Flower Square is joined to one side edge of First Flower Square using ch-4 joins (see Stitch Explanations).

Rnd 4 (joining rnd):

Work to 2nd corner: SI st in first 2 ch of first ch-4 sp, ch 3, 2-dc CI in same ch-4 sp (beg ch-3 and following 2-dc CI count as first 3-dc CI), ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, (3-dc CI, ch 4, 3-dc CI) in next corner ch-4 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4:

Work along next edge AND join the edge to ONE edge of previous Flower Square: 3-dc Cl in next corner ch-4 sp, ch-4 join, 3-dc Cl in same corner ch-4 sp, ch-4 join, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch-4 join, 3-dc Cl in next ch-4

sp, ch-4 join, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch-4 join, 3-dc Cl in next corner ch-4 sp, ch-4 join, 3-dc Cl in same corner ch-4 sp;

Work to end of rnd: Ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, 3-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, (3-dc Cl, ch 4, 3-dc Cl) in next corner ch-4 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4; join with sl st in first cluster.

Fasten off.

Third Flower Square

Make same as Second Flower Square, joining one side edge of current Flower Square to one side edge of previous Flower Square to form a strip.

Fourth Flower Square

Make same as Second Flower Square, joining one side edge of current Flower Square to one side edge of First Flower Square, to beg next row of Flower Squares.

Fifth Flower Square

Ch 5; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnds 1-3: Work same as Rnds 1-3 of First Flower Square.

Note: Rnd 4 is worked the same as Rnd 4 of First Flower Square, EXCEPT that two side edges of current Flower are joined to one side edge of Second Flower and one side edge of Flower Four.

Rnd 4 (joining rnd):

Work to 2nd corner: SI st in first 2 ch of first ch-4 sp, ch 3, 2-dc CI in same ch-4 sp (beg ch-3 and following 2-dc CI count as first 3-dc CI), ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, (3-dc CI, ch 4, 3-dc CI) in next corner ch-4 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4;

Work along next 2 edges AND join each of these edges to one edge of 2 previous Flower Squares: 3-dc Cl in next corner ch-4 sp, ch-4 join, 3-dc Cl in same corner ch-4 sp, *ch-4 join, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch-4 join, 3-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch-4 join, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch-4 join, 3-dc Cl in next corner ch-4 sp, ch-4 join, 3-dc Cl in same corner ch-4 sp; rep from * once more:

Work to end of rnd: Ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4; join with sl st in first cluster.

Fasten off.

Sixth Flower Square

Make same as Fifth Flower Square, joining one side edge of current Flower Square to one side edge of Third Flower Square and next side edge to Fifth Flower Square.

Seventh, Eighth, and Ninth Flower Squares

Make same as Fourth, Fifth, and Sixth Flower Squares, joining to previous row of Flower Squares to complete a 3rd row of Flower Squares.

Tenth, Eleventh, and Twelfth Flower Squares

Make same as Fourth, Fifth, and Sixth Flower Squares, joining to previous row of Flower Squares to complete a 4th row of Flower Squares.

Thirteenth, Fourteenth, and Fifteenth Flower Squares

Make same as Fourth, Fifth, and Sixth Flower Squares, joining to previous row of Flower Squares to complete a 5th row of Flower Squares.

Neck

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join yarn with sc in top right corner ch-4 sp, *ch 2, sk next Cl, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next Cl, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2 **, sk next Cl, sc in join between Flower Squares; rep from * across top edge ending last rep at **, sc in top left corner ch-4 sp - 12 Cl, 24 ch-2 sps, and 13 sc.

Rows 2-6: Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Lace pattern for 5 rows – 11 ch-5 sps, 12 sc, 2 ch-2 sps, and 2 dc in Row 6.

Right Shoulder

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, sk first ch-2 sp, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp) 3 times; leave rem sts unworked for back neck and left shoulder – 3 Cl, 6 ch-2 sps, and 4 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sk first sc, sl st in next 2 ch, sc in next Cl, (ch 5, sc in next Cl) twice, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in last sc – 2 ch-5 sps, 3 sc, 1 ch-2 sp, and 1 dc. Fasten off.

Left Shoulder

Row 1 (RS): Sk first 5 unworked ch-5 sps following right shoulder, join yarn with sc in next ch-5 sp, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp) 3 times working last sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5 – 3 Cl, 6 ch-2 sps and 4 sc.

Row 2: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, sc in next Cl, (ch 5, sc in next Cl) twice; leave rem sts unworked – 2 ch-5 sps, 3 sc, 1 ch-2 sp, and 1 dc. Fasten off.

FRONT

Make same as Back to Neck.

Neck

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join yarn with sc in top right corner ch-4 sp, *ch 2, sk next Cl, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next Cl, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2 **, sk next Cl, sc in join between Flower Squares; rep from * across top edge ending last rep at **, sc in top left corner ch-4 sp - 12 Cl, 24 ch-2 sps, and 13 sc.

Row 2: Work Row 2 of Lace pattern – 11 ch-5 sps, 12 sc, 2 ch-2 sps, and 2 dc.

Left Shoulder

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, sk first ch-2 sp, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp) 5 times; leave rem sts unworked for front neck and right shoulder – 5 Cl, 10 ch-2 sps, and 6 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sk first sc, sl st in next 2 ch, sc in next Cl, (ch 5, sc in next Cl) 4 times, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in last sc – 4 ch-5 sps, 5 sc, 1 ch-2 sp, and 1 dc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, sk first ch-2 sp, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp) 4 times; leave rem sts unworked – 4 Cl, 8 ch-2 sps, and 5 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sk first sc, sl st in next 2 ch, sc in next Cl, (ch 5, sc in next Cl) 3 times, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in last sc – 3 ch-5 sps, 4 sc, 1 ch-2 sp, and 1 dc.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, sk first ch-2 sp, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp) 3 times; leave rem sts unworked – 3 Cl, 6 ch-2 sps, and 4 sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sk first sc, sl st in next 2 ch, sc in next Cl, (ch 5, sc in next Cl) twice, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in last sc – 2 ch-5 sps, 3 sc, 1 ch-2 sp, and 1 dc.

Shoulder Joining Row: Hold Front and Back with RS tog and sts matching. Working from WS and through both thicknesses, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, (ch 5, sc in next ch-5 sp) twice. Fasten off.

Right Shoulder

Row 1 (RS): Sk first unworked ch-5 sp following left shoulder, join yarn with sc in next ch-5 sp, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp) 5 times working last sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5 – 5 Cl, 10 ch-2 sps, and 6 sc.

Row 2: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, sk first ch-2 sp, sc in next Cl, (ch 5, sc in next Cl) 4 times; leave rem sts unworked – 4 ch-5 sps, 5 sc, 1 ch-2 sp, and 1 dc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sk first sc, sl st in next 2 ch, sc in next ch, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp) 4 times working last sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5 - 4 Cl, 8 ch-2 sps, and 5 sc.

Row 4: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, sk first ch-2 sp, sc in next Cl, (ch 5, sc in next Cl) 3 times; leave rem sts unworked – 3 ch-5 sps, 4 sc, 1 ch-2 sp, and 1 dc.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sk first sc, sl st in next 2 ch, sc in next ch, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp) 3 times working last sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5 - 3 Cl, 6 ch-2 sps, and 4 sc.

Row 6: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, sk first ch-2 sp, sc in next Cl, (ch 5, sc in next Cl) twice; leave rem sts unworked – 2 ch-5 sps, 3 sc, 1 ch-2 sp, and 1 dc.

Shoulder Joining Row: Hold Front and Back with RS tog and sts matching. SI st in first 2 ch of first ch-5 sp of Front; working from WS and through both thicknesses, sc in first ch-5 sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 5, sc in last st. Fasten off.

Sides

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join yarn with sc in one lower corner ch-4 sp of Front so that you are ready to work up the side edge, *ch 2, sk next Cl, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next Cl, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2 **, sk

next Cl, sc in join between Flower Squares; rep from * along side edge of Front ending last rep at **; working in ends of rows of Front neck and shoulder, sc in end of first row, sk next row, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in end of next row, ch 2, sc in end of next row) twice, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in end of next row, ch 2, sk end of next row, sc in end of Shoulder Joining Row; working in ends of rows of Back shoulder, sk next row, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in end of next row, ch 2, sc in end of next row) twice, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in end of next row, ch 2, sk end of next row, sc in end of last row; work along side edge of Back in same way as you worked along side edge of Front ending with sc in lower corner ch-4 sp of Back – 46 Cl, 92 ch-2 sps, and 47 sc.

Rows 2-6 (12, 18): Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Lace pattern for 5 (11, 17) rows – you will have 46 sc, 45 ch-5 sps, 2 ch-2 sps, and 2 dc in WS rows. Fasten off.

Rep along 2nd side edge beg in lower Back corner ch-4 sp.

SLEEVES

Row 1 (RS): From RS of Front and working along side edge of Front, join yarn with sc in 16th (15th, 14th) ch-5 sp above lower edge, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp) 14 (16, 18) times; leave rem 15 (14, 13) ch-5 sps unworked – 14 (16, 18) Cl, 28 (32, 36) ch-2 sps, and 15 (17, 19) sc.

Rows 2-4: Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Lace pattern for 3 rows – 14 (16, 18) sc, 13 (15, 17) ch-5 sps, 2 ch-2 sps, and 2 dc.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first ch-2 sp, *ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp; rep from * to last sc, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in last sc, ch 2, sl st in last ch-sp; leave rem st unworked – 14 (16, 18) Cl, 26 (30, 34) ch-2 sps, and 13 (15, 17) sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sk sl st, sl st in next 2 ch, sc in first Cl, *ch 5, sc in next Cl; rep from * across, leave beg ch-2 unworked – 14 (16, 18) sc and 13 (15, 17) ch-5 sps.

Row 7: Ch 2, dc in first st (beg ch-2 and following dc count as first Cl), turn, *ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc; rep from * across – 14 (16, 18) Cl, 26 (30, 34) ch-2 sps, and 13 (15, 17) sc.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc in first Cl, *ch 5, sc in next Cl; rep from * across.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 2 ch of first ch-5 sp, sc in same ch-5 sp, *ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp; rep from * across; leave last st unworked – 12 (14, 16) Cl, 24 (28, 32) ch-2 sps, and 13 (15, 17) sc.

Rows 10-14: Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Lace pattern for 5 rows - 12 (14, 16) sc, 11 (13, 15) ch-5 sps, 2 ch-2 sps, and 2 dc in WS rows.

Rows 15-19: Rep Rows 5-9 – 10 (12, 14) Cl, 20 (24, 28) ch-2 sps, and 11 (13, 15) sc in Row 19.

Rows 20-28: Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Lace pattern for 9 rows - 10 (12, 14) sc, 9 (11, 13) ch-5 sps, 2 ch-2 sps and 2 dc in WS rows.

Rows 29-33: Rep Rows 5-9 – 8 (10, 12) Cl, 16 (20, 24) ch-2 sps, and 9 (11, 13) sc in Row 33.

Rows 34-42: Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Lace pattern for 9 rows -8 (10, 12) sc, 7 (9, 11) ch-5 sps, 2 ch-2 sps and 2 dc in WS rows.

Last Row: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, ch 2, sc in next sc, *ch 5, sc in next sc; rep from * to beg ch-5, ch 2, sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5. Do NOT fasten off.

Sleeve and Side Seams

Fold piece in half along shoulder line and match ends of rows and sts along Sleeve and side edges. Working through both thicknesses, sc in end of last row of Sleeve, work (ch 3, sc in edge) evenly spaced along Sleeve edge and side edge to about 5 1/2 (4 1/2, 4) in. (14 (11.5, 10) cm) above lower edge, leave rem of side edge unjoined for side slit. Fasten off.

Rep Sleeve on other side, beg in 16th (15th, 14th) ch-5 sp of side edge of Back above lower edge.

Lower Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join yarn with a sc in beg corner of lower edge of Front; working in ends of rows of sides, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in end of next row, ch 2, sc in end of next row) 3 (6, 9) times working last sc in corner ch-3 sp of Flower Square, *ch 2, sk next Cl, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2, 2-dc Cl in next ch-4 sp, ch 2 **, sk next Cl, sc in join between Flower Squares; rep from * across lower edge ending last rep at **, sc in corner ch-4 sp; working in ends of rows of Side, (ch 2, 2-dc Cl in end of next row, ch 2, sc in end of next row) 3 (6, 9) times.

Rows 2-4 (6, 8): Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Lace pattern for 3 (5, 7) rows.

Fasten off.

Rep Lower Edging along lower edge of Back. Do NOT fasten off.

Last Rnd (RS): Ch 1, turn, *sc in first dc, ch 2, sc in next sc, **ch 5, sc in next sc; rep from ** to beg ch-5, ch 2, sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5; working up one side of slit and down the other, ch 2, sc in end of next row, (ch 5, sc in edge) as evenly spaced as possible to end of slit, ch 2; rep from * along lower edge of Front and 2nd side slit; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Neck Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join with sc in neck edge at one shoulder seam, *ch 5, sc in edge; rep from * as evenly spaced as possible around neck edge; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
