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<u>SKILL LEVEL</u> – Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 16 x 70 in. (40.5 x 178 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Shawl in a Ball (Art. #828)
 - 202 Calming Desert 2 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size G-6 (4.25 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

<u>GAUGE</u>



1 pattern rep = about 2 3/4 in. (7 cm). **Note:** One pattern rep in Row 1 consists of one (ch 3, sc, ch 3) group and the following (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) group. One pattern rep in other rows consists of the sts worked into one rep of previous row.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. The Shawl is worked in one piece.
- 2. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

SHAWL

Ch 90.

Row 1: Dc in 6th ch from hook (5 skipped ch count as 1 base ch, first dc and ch 1), ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch, ch 3, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch, ch 3, sk next 3 ch, dc in next ch, *(ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) 3 times, ch 3, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch, ch 3, sk next 3 ch, dc in next ch; rep from * to last 4 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch, dc in next ch, it last 4 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch, dc in next ch, it last 4 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch, dc in next ch, it last 4 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch, dc in next ch, it last 4 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch, dc in next ch, it last 4 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch, dc in next ch) twice – you will have 6 (ch 3, sc, ch 3) groups, 5 (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) groups, and a (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) group at the beg and end of this row (for 5 pattern reps; the additional (ch 3, sc, ch 3) group and the beg and end (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) groups combined measure a little more than one additional rep).

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, (dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) twice, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, *(dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) 3 times, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 ch-sps, dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 4th ch of beg ch.

Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, *(ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc) 3 times, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc; rep from * to last 4 dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, (dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) twice, ch 7, sk next 2 ch-3 sps, dc in next dc, *(dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) 3 times, ch

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7, sk next 2 ch-3 sps, dc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 ch-sps, dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

Row 5: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next st, ch 3, sc in 4th ch of next ch-7 sp, ch 3, dc in next dc, *(ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc) 3 times, ch 3, sc in 4th ch of next ch-7 sp, ch 3, dc in next dc; rep from * to last 4 dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc,

Rep Rows 2-5 until piece measures about 70 in. (178 cm) from beg or until desired length, end with a Row 3 as the last row you work. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
